

CITY OF MUSCATINE
REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
Council Chambers – 7:00 p.m. – August 7, 2014

Mayor Hopkins called the City Council meeting for Thursday, August 7, 2014, to order at 7:00 p.m. Councilmembers present were Rehwaldt, Fitzgerald, Natvig, Shihadeh, Bynum, Phillips, and Spread.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

#22905. Councilmember Spread, seconded by Councilmember Fitzgerald, moved the Consent Agenda be approved as follows:

- Regular City Council minutes of July 17, 2014
- Approval of Use of City Property from Apostolic Temple of Victory #3 Church for a Prayer Walk on August 9, 2014 beginning at 9:00 a.m.
- Appointments of Clair Penner and Jon Moravec to the Art Center Board of Trustees
- Filing of Communications 12A-G
- Approval of Bills for Approval totaling \$3,306,755.61

Vote – All ayes; motion carried.

PUBLIC HEARING

Mayor Hopkins stated a public hearing was being held concerning the proposed 2014 Asphalt Overlay Project.

There were no oral or written petitions for or against the proposed project.

#22906. Councilmember Natvig moved the public hearing be closed. Seconded by Councilmember Fitzgerald. All ayes; motion carried.

#22907. Councilmember Bynum moved the resolution be adopted approving the plans, specifications, form of contract, cost estimate and setting the bid opening date for the 2014 Asphalt Overlay Project. Seconded by Councilmember Phillips. All ayes: Councilmembers Rehwaldt, Fitzgerald, Natvig, Shihadeh, Bynum, Phillips, and Spread. Motion carried.

#22908. Councilmember Spread moved the resolution be adopted reclassifying Iowa 92 from US 61 northeasterly to the intersection of Iowa 92/38. Seconded by Councilmember Fitzgerald. All ayes: Councilmembers Rehwaldt, Fitzgerald, Natvig, Shihadeh, Bynum, Phillips, and Spread. Motion carried.

#22909. Councilmember Bynum moved the resolution be adopted changing the name of a portion of Cherry Street to Juniper Street. Seconded by Councilmember Spread. All ayes: Councilmembers Rehwaldt, Fitzgerald, Natvig, Shihadeh, Bynum, Phillips, and Spread. Motion carried.

#22910. Councilmember Natvig moved the resolution be adopted accepting completed work for the Security Improvements Gate and Camera Project at the Municipal Airport and authorizing final payment to FSS Inc. Seconded by Councilmember Shihadeh. All ayes: Councilmembers Rehwaldt, Fitzgerald, Natvig, Shihadeh, Bynum, Phillips, and Spread. Motion carried.

#22911. Councilmember Phillips moved the resolution be adopted setting a public hearing on an Urban Renewal Plan Amendment for Thursday, September 4, 2014, at 7:00 p.m. Seconded by Councilmember Spread. All ayes: Councilmembers Rehwaldt, Fitzgerald, Natvig, Shihadeh, Bynum, Phillips, and Spread. Motion carried.

#22912. Councilmember Spread moved the resolution be adopted accepting the low bid for the Green Physical Needs Assessment (GPNA) and awarding the contract to AEI Consulting of Chicago, Illinois, in the amount of \$6,900. Seconded by Councilmember Natvig.

There was discussion concerning the GPNA and its purpose.

Vote – All ayes: Councilmembers Rehwaldt, Fitzgerald, Natvig, Shihadeh, Bynum, Phillips, and Spread. Motion carried.

#22913. Councilmember Bynum moved to approve the request from the Police Department to use a grant from the Roy Carver Charitable Trust to purchase a second K-9. Seconded by Councilmember Shihadeh.

City Administrator Gregg Mandsager stated HNI will be awarding the city a \$4,500 grant to provide the kennel and vehicle change over costs.

Vote – All ayes; motion carried.

#22914. Councilmember Natvig moved to approve the request from the Police Department to purchase eight Taser X26P units from Taser International in the amount of \$7,494.40, excluding shipping. Seconded by Councilmember Fitzgerald. All ayes; motion carried.

#22915. Councilmember Shihadeh moved to accept the grant agreement from the Federal Aviation Administration for the Runway and Taxiway Reconstruction Design Only at the Municipal Airport. Seconded by Councilmember Fitzgerald. All ayes; motion carried.

Under comments, Councilmember Rehwaldt requested a thank you be sent to HNI for their donation to the city to assist with the purchase of the second K-9.

Councilmember Fitzgerald stated he was glad to see the completion of the security gate at the airport.

#22916. Councilmember Shihadeh moved the meeting be adjourned at 7:15 p.m. Seconded by Councilmember Fitzgerald. All ayes; motion carried.
