REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MINUTES  
Council Chambers – 7:00 p.m. – January 8, 2015

Mayor Hopkins called the City Council meeting for Thursday, January 8, 2015, to order at 7:00 p.m. Councilmembers present were Fitzgerald, Natvig, Shihadeh, Bynum, and Spread.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

#22872. Councilmember Shihadeh, seconded by Councilmember Bynum, moved the Consent Agenda be approved as follows:

#22873. Councilmember Spread moved the resolution be adopted setting a public hearing on the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract, and cost estimate for the Dredge Line Mad Creek Extension Project for Thursday, February 5, 2015, at 7:00 p.m. Seconded by Councilmember Natvig. All ayes: Councilmembers Fitzgerald, Natvig, Shihadeh, Bynum, and Spread. Motion carried.

#22874. Councilmember Spread moved the resolution be adopted authorizing the submission of an application to the Iowa Department of Economic Development for Community Attraction & Tourism (CAT) program funding for the Pearl of the Mississippi Phase III – Community Improvement Project. Seconded by Councilmember Natvig. All ayes: Councilmembers Fitzgerald, Natvig, Shihadeh, Bynum, and Spread. Motion carried.

#22875. Councilmember Fitzgerald moved to approve Change Order #2 for the Forest Parkway Reconstruction Project. Seconded by Councilmember Bynum.

Councilmember Fitzgerald stated he thought the blankets would have been part of the contract since the project was taking place in October and November.

City Administrator Mandsager stated the blankets were part of the bid specifications.

Public Works Director Randy Hill stated they were part of the bid specifications. He then stated the amount the contractor is seeking is the amount the DOT would pay for the blankets.

Councilmember Fitzgerald asked if there were any other change orders coming, and Mr. Hill answered no.

#22876. Councilmember Fitzgerald moved to approve Change Order #1 for the Geneva Creek Channel Reshaping Project. Seconded by Councilmember Natvig. All ayes; motion carried.

#22877. Councilmember Natvig moved to approve Change Order #5 for the Colorado Street Project. Seconded by Councilmember Fitzgerald. All ayes; motion carried.

#22878. Councilmember Bynum moved to approve the request from the Police Department for the purchase of a Cellebrite Touch Ultimate Mobile Forensics Software System and associated software. Seconded by Councilmember Spread. All ayes; motion carried.

Under comments, Councilmember Bynum invited City Council to the Miss Muscatine Pageant being held at 7 p.m. on Saturday at Central Middle School.

#22879. Councilmember Shihadeh moved the meeting be adjourned at 7:10 p.m. Seconded by Councilmember Fitzgerald. All ayes; motion carried.
