Request – Alexander Clark Temporary Memorial

A short presentation was given by the Alexander Clark Committee. This item was tabled until the Committee provides written documentation to support the request for a temporary display.

Presentation – Trail Safety Program

Klimes discussed the Trail Safety Program. Volunteers would have motorized carts stocked with safety supplies and would monitor the trails. They would communicate with the Sheriff and Police Department as needed. A grant will be written to receive a vehicle for the program.

Update – Park Maintenance Building Project

Klimes provided update on the Park Maintenance Building Project. The project should be done this fall and will come in under budget. Will give Commission members a tour once it is finished.

Update – Special Event Calendar

Klimes provided brief update on the Parks and Recreation Department's Special Event Calendar.

Other Business

Klimes informed the Commission there is a group in town that would like to fix the old tennis courts at Eversmeyer Park into pickle ball courts. They will submit a request for the next Commission meeting.

Klimes stated the Parks and Recreation Department is getting calls that cars are driving on the Greenbelt pathway and a request has come in to put trail gates up. Klimes asked the Commission to contact the Parks and Recreation Department if they see anything unusual on the trails.
