

City Administrator Report to Mayor & City Council

January 27, Edition No. 254

WEEKLY UPDATE:

- Budget: Attached is a digital copy of the powerpoint for the proposed budget. Our first session is tomorrow at 8am in the Lower Level Conference Room.
- PD Survey: Please see the attached Muscatine Police Department Community Survey.
- DNR: IDNR has approved the financial assistance in order to conduct a pre-acquisition Phase I Environmental Site Assessment and asbestos inspection of the former Kent Feeds facility on Green St., and for the planned asbestos inspection of the former Beach Building Center / lumber yard on Hershey Ave.
- Carver Corner: The Fire Department has tentatively set the training burn for March 11th, with a rain date/make up for the following Saturday of March 18th.
- Community Development: According to City Planner Fangman, Kum & Go has acquired the old Sun Mart site located at the northeast corner of 4th and Cedar Street, their intent is to relocate their existing store at the northwest corner of 5th and Cedar Street to this location. As part of this proposed development, Kum & Go is requesting the vacation of the alley running through this block, between Sycamore Street and Cedar Street. This alley vacation will formally begin with a hearing and recommendation by the Planning & Zoning Commission at their February meeting, after which the request will move on to Council. Staff will be recommending approval of this vacation request as this alley does not know or in the foreseeable future serve a public purpose, nor does it extend east of Cedar Street in a publicly accessible form. Typically, in a vacation like this, the City sells the vacated right of way to the adjoining property owner at fair market value. However, in this case City Staff and Kum & Go have come to a tentative understanding on a potential alternative to a straight cash sale of the right of way being proposed for vacation, that will benefit the community more than the simple fair market value of the vacated alley in cash. Under this tentative understanding, in exchange for title to the vacated alley, Kum & Go would construct 20 on-street parking spaces along Sycamore Street between 4th Street and 5th Street. These spaces shall meet all the following criteria. (see attached site plan)
 - Be 9.5' by 18' in size
 - Be at 90° to Sycamore Street
 - Curb bump outs of at least 9' by 18' at the ends of each row of parking spaces.

Further, Kum & Go will dedicate to the City of Muscatine the ROW necessary to contain the above described parking space and adjoining sidewalk. These 20 new on-street parking stalls would be a net increase of 9 parking spaces from the current 11 on-street parking spaces that currently exist in this location. These 9 additional on-street parking spaces will be of great value, construction of the proposed Kum & Go will displace a significant number of downtown workers that

are currently parking at the vacant Sun Mart site. These 9 space will also mitigate the loss of a number of on-street parking spaces along 4th and 5th Streets due to new curb cuts associated with the new Kum & Go.

- MPW: MPW provided the following information after being contacted by AC Phil Sargent - MPW double checked our records and noted that there was a controller failure at night around September 18, 2016. The technician replaced the controller and indicated he set the timings and must have inadvertently entered the wrong yellow light time (the old pre-ATE installation time). The controller was replaced a second time on or about December 12, 2016 and it appears the controller timing specifications were set correctly during that replacement. For approximately three months the intersection would have had been operating at an incorrect yellow light timing instead of the correct 4.3 seconds post-ATE installation time. MPW is in the process of checking all controllers in the City to make sure all timings have been maintained per specification and reviewing internal processes for ways to improve traffic signal controller maintenance practices. The technicians are aware of the need to enter accurate data into the controllers and MPW apologizes for the issues resulting from their mistake. The minimum timing for this intersection is 3.5 seconds. GATSO reviewed the issue and the following information has been harvested from their data in reference to paid red light violations from the Cleveland/Park Avenue intersection during the time MPW notes above. There were 1149 paid citations where red light time was 1 second or less. This will equate to refunds totaling \$91,990.00 for paid citations where red light time was 1 sec or less. After meeting with Chief Talkington and AC Sargent yesterday, the Police Department is working with GATSO to ensure that refunds are processed. We will be meeting with MPW and working to ensure that this issue does not happen. This is the first issue we have had with the timing. Again, just to be clear - this issue is not related to the ATE systems or equipment provided by GATSO nor police review, but rather a signal timing and maintenance issue.

More Good News!

- **The proposed General Fund balance is on target with the updated General Fund Balance Policy which provides that the minimum fund balance be equal to two months of expenditures or 16.7%**
- **For the last six years the ending balances were:**
 - **13.6% of expenditures at the end of 2010/2011**
 - **20.4% for 2011/2012**
 - **17.9% for 2012/2013**
 - **19.2% for 2013/2014**
 - **22.6% for 2014/2015**
 - **23.1% for 2015/2016**
 - **22.9% for the 2016/2017 revised estimate (the original budget was 19.5%)**
 - **22.5% for the proposed 2017/2018 budget**

Property Valuations

- **Actual Valuations (100%)**
 - Increased by \$26,638,628 (2.04%) including Tax Increment values
 - Increased by \$19,024,521 (1.52%) excluding Tax Increment values
- **Taxable Valuations**
 - Increased in total by \$24,268,411 (2.95%) – this is the 3rd largest increase in the last 10 years.
 - Residential Rollback to 56.9391% compared to 55.6259% (an increase of 2.36%)
 - Residential valuations increased by \$14,253,109 - an increase of 2.99%
 - Commercial Property remained at the 90% rollback. Valuations increased by \$7,149,043 (3.54%).
 - Multi-Residential values are \$32,996,982 (a decrease of 2.48%) and are rolled back to 82.50% of actual valuations. These properties will continue to be rolled back over the next 6 years until the rollback equals the residential rollback.
 - Industrial property remained at the 90% rollback. Industrial valuations increased by \$3,723,053 (3.44%).
 - Railroad and utility valuations also have the 90% rollback – railroad values increased by \$116,734 (19.56%) and utilities decreased by \$173,560 (4.26%)

Proposed Tax Levy

- **General Fund at maximum \$8.10/\$1,000 levy rate**
- **Tax Rate Changes**
 - **Tort Liability Levy Decreased 4.89%** (primarily due to stable premium costs with the Iowa Community Assurance Pool (ICAP) and the increased valuations).
 - **Debt Service Levy Decreased – 3.24%** due to increased valuations and favorable rates on the 2016 bond issue.
 - **Employee Benefits Levy Increased 4.08%** (reflects funding \$230,218 of employee benefits from the General Fund balance and the use of \$54,337 in beginning fund balance in the Employee Benefits fund). The most significant benefit cost increase this year is in health insurance.
 - **Transit Levy Decreased 51.28%** (increased grant funding, reduced bus maintenance costs, the transit fare increase effective July 1, 2015, and having a sufficient Transit fund balance to use for the local share of bus and other capital purchases).
 - **Levee Tax Levy at \$.06750 /\$1,000 maximum**
- **Emergency Levy again not levied. This provides the property tax relief required by the Utility Franchise Fee Revenue Purpose Statement**
- **Again, there is no change in the overall tax rate in the proposed budget.**

Other Tax Levy-Related Information

- **As noted previously, the General Fund Property Tax Rate remains at the maximum \$8.10/\$1,000 limit.**
- **With the increase in taxable values, the \$8.10 General Fund tax rate will generate \$196,574 more in tax revenue compared to the 2016/2017 year.**
- **As part of the 2013 property tax legislation, the budget is based on the State continuing to reimburse local governments for lost tax revenue resulting from the rollback of commercial and industrial property.**
- **For the General Fund \$8.10 levy, the State reimbursement is estimated at \$314,128 for 2017/2018, compared to the 2016/2017 estimated reimbursement of \$325,049.**
- **The State reimbursement, however, has been capped at the 2016/2017 funding level and there is no reimbursement for the Multi-Residential property rollbacks which will continue over the next six years.**
- **The State reimbursement also applies to the City's other tax levies and the total amount of the State reimbursement is estimated at \$607,782 for 2017/2018, compared to \$628,915 for 2016/2017.**

Proposed General Fund Budget

- **Proposed General Fund Expenditures and funding transfers for 2017/2018 are \$598,851 (3.2%) higher than the expenditures and transfers out in the 2016/2017 budget.**
- **Proposed General Fund Revenues and Other Sources (including transfers in) increased by \$676,226 (3.6%) compared to the prior year.**
- **The proposed 2017/2018 budget is truly “balanced” with budgeted revenues approximately the same as budgeted expenditures. The fund balance was not used to fund any operating expenditures in the proposed budget for 2017/2018.**
- **The ending balance is 22.5% of General Fund expenditures which more than meets the minimum fund balance of 16.7% in the City’s policy. Per the policy, funds in excess of the minimum can be used for one-time expenditures (capital items) but should not be used for operating expenditures. In prior years the City made several one-time capital budget allocations from the fund balance (fire engine, financial software, and an ambulance). No one-time capital allocations were included in the 2016/2017 budget or the 2017/2018 proposed budget.**

Proposed General Fund Budget Assumptions

The proposed General Fund budget continues the current service levels provided to residents of the community. Significant budget items and assumptions include the following:

1. The budget includes funding for Police and Fire pension contribution of \$1,352,865. While this is a modest \$17,840 increase from 2016/2017 due to the contribution rate decreasing from 25.92% to 25.68%, this is still a significant cost to the City.
2. The budget includes a 2.90% cost of living increase for both union and non-union employees. This is the rate in each of the City's union contracts for 2017/2018.
3. The revised estimate for 2016/2017 and the proposed budget for 2017/2018 reflect increased health insurance premiums. Rates were increased by 15% effective January 1, 2016 and by an additional 15% January 1, 2017. The 2017/2018 budget allows for an additional 8% increase January 1, 2018. These were the only significant rate increases since 2008. Health insurance cost increases appear to be an industry trend.
4. The four additional firefighter positions added in the 2016/2017 budget are maintained in the proposed 2017/2018 budget.
5. The proposed 2017/2018 General Fund budget includes an increase of 1.74 in fulltime equivalent (FTE) positions. There is a 1.88 FTE increase in the Building and Grounds budget for the addition of three (3) 25 hour per week janitor/custodian positions. Two of these positions are in place of the previously contracted cleaning services for City Hall and the current library. With the additional space in the new library, the third part-time position is expected to be needed to maintain the new building. There is a net cost increase of \$29,900 with this change, but the new positions will assist in maintaining the new library and also allow Building and Grounds the flexibility to use the positions where most needed. The other change was a .14 FTE reduction in the Library due to staff realignments.

Proposed General Fund Budget Assumptions (Cont.)

6. **For 2017/2018 TIF funds will continue to be used to fund City economic development administrative and marketing costs (\$148,900) as well as economic development efforts of the Chamber (GMCCI) (\$38,000).**
7. **The budget continues subsidies to outside agencies. Subsidies to GMCCI, Senior Resources, and the Humane Society are shown at their current levels. Senior Resources requested an increase from their current \$20,000 annual allocation to \$30,000. GMCCI and the Humane Society did not request increases in their allocations (\$38,000 and \$65,000, respectively).**
8. **In 2015/2016 the City budgeted for a one-time subsidy of \$25,000 to MCSA for their Homeless Prevention Program. This same allocation was included in the 2016/2017 budget. MCSA has requested continued funding of \$25,000 for their program. This has been included in the proposed budget; however, this allocation will be further reviewed as part of the budget discussions.**
9. **The budget reflects continuing the CVB's funding allocation at 25% of actual prior year hotel/motel tax revenue. This amount is estimated at \$90,400 for 2017/2018. The CVB is now an enterprise fund of the City.**
10. **The budget continues funding contributions to the Equipment Replacement Fund and Computer Replacement Fund equivalent to the needs for 2017/2018 and future years.**

Proposed General Fund Budget Assumptions (Cont.)

11. The proposed budget is based on positioning the City to address economic challenges, maintain existing levels of the services to the community, and positioning the City to meet new challenges. Future challenges could involve potential shortfalls in revenues from limited growth in taxable valuations resulting from the 2013 property tax legislation and potential loss of revenue from the automatic traffic enforcement cameras.
12. In the event of significant revenue losses after adoption of the budget, the City has established the Utility Franchise Fee which can be changed by City Council action with 90 days notice from the current 1% level up to 5%. Each 1% of franchise fee revenue is estimated to generate \$85,000. No change in the Utility Franchise Fee is included in the proposed budget, but increasing those funds could be considered in the event of future revenue reductions.
13. The budget submitted for Council consideration is proposed as a budget to find a balance between:
 - * Overall City property tax rate
 - * Maintaining a strong General Fund balance - the ending balance in the proposed budget is 22.5% of General Fund expenditures, which more than meets the minimum fund balance of 16.7% in the updated General Fund Balance Policy
 - * Providing departments with the personnel resources and equipment needed to perform their department functions efficiently.

Proposed General Fund Budget Assumptions (Cont.)

- 14. The 2016/2017 budget continues City (and School) funding for the two added police officer positions. The 3-year COPS grant period and required 4th year for maintaining those positions ended in April of 2016.**

- 15. The 2015/2016 and 2016/2017 budgets included a number of significant building and facility improvement costs which are being funded from the City's June 2016 bond issue. The projects funded include a significant portion of the cost of the HVAC replacement at the Art Center, roof replacements at City Hall and a portion of the Public Safety Building; tuck-pointing the Music Room at the Art Center; replacement of the playground surface at Musser Park; replacing Rip Rap on a portion of the riverfront; and replacing Rip Rap along the Slough Bank in Kent Stein Park.**

- 16. Departments requested consideration of numerous other significant building, facility, and parks improvements or maintenance items. These are listed in a schedule in the General Information section of the proposed budget document. Consideration should be given to including these types of items in the 2018 or future bond issues.**

Recent Trends in Property Tax Rates, Police and Fire Pension Contributions, and Department Efficiency Savings

Property Taxes

In 2008/2009 the City's property tax levy rate was \$16.15095. Since that time it has decreased and fluctuated between \$15.55353 and the \$15.77146. The levy proposed for 2017/2018 is \$15.67209 which is \$.48/\$1,000 of valuation less than the FY 09 rate. This levy rate has been maintained for the past six years.

Police and Fire Pension Rates and Contributions

Police and fire pension costs have increased from \$654,034 in 2009/2010 when the contribution rate was 17.00% to \$1,352,865 for 2017/2018 with the 25.68% contribution rate. This is a \$698,831 increase and an increase of 106.9% over this 9-year period. While modest decreases in the pension rate are now forecasted, these rates and contributions will continue to have a significant impact on the City's budget.

Recent Trends in Property Tax Rates, Police and Fire Pension Contributions, and Department Efficiency Savings (Cont.)

Structural Changes and Department Efficiencies

There have been numerous structural changes and department efficiencies implemented over the last several years. These are listed in an attachment to the General Fund Budget Message in Council's notebooks. (Changes with specific ongoing cost savings or revenue enhancements total over \$350,000 on an annual basis; if the establishment of the Utility Franchise Fee would be included, the total would be higher). Those lists also include items which may not have specific dollar amounts of savings directly associated with them, but have allowed departments to redirect their resources to operate more efficiently and/or provide better services. Efforts will continue in the current and upcoming budget years to implement formal "Lean" or Continuous Service Improvement programs which will seek to identify and implement additional efficiencies and structural changes to continue to improve how the City provides services to the community.

Implementation of these changes has assisted the City in reducing the impact of rising costs and has also lessened the impact these costs have on the City's property tax rate.

Impact of Residential, Commercial, and Industrial Property Rollbacks

- While the City property tax rate is proposed to remain at \$15.67209 for the upcoming year, the amount of property taxes paid by homeowners will increase due to the change in the State rollback factor for residential property which increased from 55.6259% to 56.9391% (an increase of 2.36%) in 2017/2018.
- The impact the residential rollback change will have on a home valued at \$100,000 would be a \$20.00 increase in annual City taxes and for a \$150,000 home it would be a \$31.00 increase.
- Commercial and Industrial values were rolled back to 95% in 2014/2015 and further rolled back to 90% in 2015/2016. These properties will remain at the 90% rollback in 2017/2018. This will result in no change in property taxes with the same tax rate.
- Multi-Residential properties were previously included in commercial property and were rolled back to 90% in 2015/2016. They are now a separate property class which was rolled back to 86.25% in 2016/2017 and further rolled back to 82.50% in 2017/2018. This will result in an \$89.00 tax reduction for a multi-residential property valued at \$150,000 compared to the previous year. The overall reduction from when these properties were valued at 100% is \$412 in annual city property taxes for a \$150,000 multi-residential property. Multi-residential properties will continue to be rolled back for the next six years until they are the same rollback as residential property.
- In effect, the property rollbacks shift the tax burden between the different classes of property. As planned under the 2013 State legislation, the rollbacks of commercial, industrial, and multi-residential properties shifted some of the tax burden from these categories of property to residential properties.

FY 18 Budget and Beyond

- Due to the property tax legislation enacted in 2013, taxable valuations are projected to see minimal or negative growth over the next 7 years.
- In 2014 the City's financial consultant, PFM, did a projection for annual changes in taxable valuations for future years based on growth assumptions and the State's projections for changes in the residential rollback each year. These projected increases (decreases) were as follows:

* The 2016/2017 actual increase of 5.44% appears to be an anomaly and it is doubtful this magnitude of increase will continue in future years unless we continue to "grow" Muscatine.

** The City's 2.95% increase in taxable valuations in FY 18 was higher than projected.

- Future assumptions include the State maintaining the backfill for the commercial and industrial property rollbacks. The backfill amount is capped at the 2016/2017 amount per the legislation.

FY 18 Budget and Beyond (Cont.)

- An ongoing multi-agency lawsuit with the IDOT or other IDOT or Legislative rules may impact future Automatic Traffic Enforcement revenues which are budgeted at \$700,000 for 2017/2018.
- \$700,000 would be equivalent to \$.83/\$1,000 of valuation in property taxes. Due to tax levy restrictions, however, this amount could not fully be made up by increasing the property tax rate.
- Utility Franchise Fees could be increased from the current 1% to 5%. With each 1% equivalent to approximately \$85,000, \$340,000 in additional revenue would be available from these fees.
- In future years (as well as the current year), the City could consider levying for 100% of General Fund employee benefits to fund a portion of the shortfall. The amount currently funded from the General Fund is \$230,218 which is equivalent to an increase of \$.27/\$1,000 in the tax rate.
- In future years the City could also consider levying the Emergency Tax levy of \$.27/\$1,000 of valuation. This would generate \$228,915.
- Tax Increment Financing (TIF) changes continue to be discussed by the State legislature.
- The State continuing to fully fund the reimbursement for the commercial and industrial rollback is also a concern for FY 18 and future years.
- Although not in the proposed budget, City Council could choose to increase the 2017/2018 tax rate to have funds available to assist with potential loss of revenues from ATE fines or if the State would not fully fund the reimbursement for commercial and industrial properties.

FY 18 Budget and Beyond (Cont.)

- **If the 2017/2018 tax rate would be increased to fund 100% of General Fund employee benefits, the tax rate would increase by \$.27153 to \$15.94362 per \$1,000 of valuation (a 1.73% increase) which would generate \$230,218. Adding this amount to the General Fund balance (IF the ATE revenue and State reimbursement would remain in place) would increase the balance to \$4,600,584 which is 23.7% of General Fund expenditures.**
- **Provisions in the General Fund Balance Policy provide that “except for extraordinary circumstances, unassigned fund balance should not be used to fund any portion of ongoing and routine operating expenditures of the City”.**
- **The policy then provides that: “Extraordinary circumstances can include significant revenue fluctuations (i.e. State legislative changes limiting property taxes, limiting automatic traffic enforcement (ATE) use, etc.). In the event that use of unassigned fund balance is necessary to provide a short-term solution to maintaining essential services, the City will evaluate current and future economic conditions to evaluate the extent of expenditure reductions or revenue increases that would be needed to achieve day-to-day financial stability and restore the fund balance.”**
- **Having a strong General Fund balance and the Fund Balance Policy in place will allow time for staff and City Council to plan for how to address revenue reductions if they occur.**
- **Recommended NEXT STEP (after legislative session) – Staff, Council, and public discussion of future revenues, expenditures, and City services for future years. The fund balance and the Utility Franchise Fee could be used in the short-term to backfill a portion of any lost revenues.**





Q7 How satisfied are you with the response time when calling the Muscatine police Department?



Q8 How satisfied are you with the Muscatine police Department's service to the community?



Q9 Do you feel your neighborhood would benefit from a program such as neighborhood watch?



Q10 If you answered YES in question 9, how interested would you be in participating in such a program?







Q13 How safe do you feel your kids are while outside in your neighborhood?



Q14 How safe do you feel your kids are while attending school?



Q15 How safe do you feel letting your kids play in the Muscatine parks?





Q17 Do you think the City of Muscatine has an adequate number of officers serving the community?






































