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West Hill Sewer Project work moving to different location

Work begins in West 4th Street Park area on Wednesday

MUSCATINE, Iowa – The West Hill Sewer Separation Project is nearly completion on the stretch of 4th street from Cedar to Chestnut with work now moving to the West 4th Street Park area.

East 4th Street between Cedar and Iowa, and West 4th Street from Iowa to Chestnut remains closed to traffic this week while Cedar and Chestnut are open. The paving from Cedar to Chestnut has been completed but the section will remain closed for another week or two until the intersections, sidewalks, and driveways in each block are completed. After that the street will be re-opened to traffic.

The sanitary and storm sewer work in the 4th Street Park area will begin Wednesday, June 7, resulting in portions of Broadway and West 4th around the park being closed to traffic.

The first portion of roadway in the 4th Street Park area (see [map](#)) to be closed for sewer work is on Broadway between West 4th Street and the #4 Alley. There will be no through-access during this portion of the project. The contractor will be installing a deep sewer line that tracks down and across the middle of the street. The rest of the street in the park area will be open but it is still in poor condition and there will be a great deal of heavy truck traffic during the day.

Once the storm sewer in the area shown is completed the contractor will begin installing the sanitary sewer at the Locust/West 4th intersection, necessitating the closure of that intersection. From there the construction will be moving back up West 4th toward and around the park. That is likely to begin during the week of June 12.
