Investigation continues into reports of shots fired in Muscatine

One man injured Thursday night; police seeks public cooperation in investigation

MUSCATINE, Iowa – Two reports of shots fired Thursday night are being investigated by the Muscatine Police Department.

On Thursday, July 27, 2017, at or about 9:50 p.m., several gun shots were reported the area of West 6th Street and Linn Street in Muscatine. Officers arrived in the area and located several shell casings in the roadway of the 500 block of Linn Street. Trinidad Santos-Salas, 36, was injured from the rounds and treated for injuries at Trinity before being transported to the University of Iowa Hospital. Suspects in this case have been located, however the case is still under investigation. At this time, this is believed to be an isolated incident and there is no additional threat to the public.

On Friday, July 28, 2017, at or about 02:40 a.m., units from the Muscatine Police Department were dispatched to the area of the 400 block of West 3rd Street for a shots fired call. Officers found several shell casings in the area of the 400 block of West 3rd Street. At this time we do not have any reports of injuries or property damage.
