## **SEGMENT OF 33rd STREET TO BE CLOSED STARTING FRIDAY**

*Work on trail project necessitates closing road for 10 days starting on Sept. 15*

**MUSCATINE, Iowa** – A section of 33rd Street South will be closed for approximately 10 days starting on Friday, Sept. 15, according to City of Muscatine Project Manager Bill Haag. The section from Stewart Road to the Canadian Pacific Rail Road tracks will be closed to traffic starting Friday morning with a tentative reopening date of Sept. 25.

The closure is part of the Kent Stein to Deep Lakes Park Trail project and will allow for a concrete trail crossing across 33rd Street South which is a mostly gravel road. All-American Concrete will be grading and pouring concrete on a 50 foot long by 22 foot wide section where the trail crosses 33rd Street South.

All-American Concrete will also be working at the CPRR crossing at Dick Drake Way on Monday, Sept. 18, pouring concrete and installing the ADA bump pads. No traffic restrictions are expected at that location but drivers are advised to be aware of the construction activity and use caution in the area.
