NO PARKING IN 800 BLOCK OF WEST 4TH STREET APR. 19-26

Sewer repair on West 4th Street will result in traffic delays; find alternate routes if possible

MUSCATINE, Iowa – Parking will be restricted in the 800 block of West 4th Street (between Cherry Street and Lucas Street) starting at 7:00 a.m. Thursday, April 19 and lasting for about a week. Matt Chandler, Collection and Drainage Supervisor for the Department of Public Works of the City of Muscatine, announced that a sewer repair will take place in that location starting Thursday.

No parking signs will be posted on both sides of the street. The 800 block of East 4th Street will not be closed but drivers should expect delays while moving through the work area. Drivers are also urged to use caution and slowdown or find an alternate route of travel.

The parking restriction is expected to last about a week with repairs completed by Thursday, Apr. 26. The completion date is dependent on the weather.
