Report

1. Hershey Sewer Separation: Langman continues work in the Green and West Third intersection. They are installing the storm sewer, manholes, intakes, and inlet pipes up 3rd (from Green) and up Green (from 3rd). They will get the storm sewer and underdrain installed, and then they will begin on the sanitary manhole and pipe. They will install sanitary sewer between the Green Street manhole and the next one up 3rd Street (near 921 West 3rd). Then they will drop back near Green Street and continue with storm sewer. The intersection will be opened to traffic as soon as Langman clears out of the intersection. Langman is also coring out and grading for Heuer on West 3rd, between Main and Green. This crew prepped for Illowa on Elm and "Little Busch" last week. Illowa is scheduled to be on the job for those streets later this week. Heuer is forming up to pour the south lane of West 3rd to the alley. They poured the bottom slab for an intake last Friday. It had to be formed and poured due to limited space around it with the gas main and Qwest duct in close proximity. Qwest has a subcontractor scheduled to rebuild the vault on West 3rd. The subcontractor told me they will be present to do that later in the week. B & B, a firm Langman uses in the Quad Cities, to find underground problems was on the Project this morning. There is a problem with a blockage in the sewer at 905 West Mississippi Drive (T NT Tattoo and U Haul). A local plumber and MP&W have tried unsuccessfully to find the exact blockage location over the last two weeks. B & B found the location. It is in the street, about 10 feet from the new sanitary sewer. Langman will be digging it up after "locates" are done. Denny Kistenmacher, City Project Manager
