- SBFL: Please see the attached story and photo on the Small Business Forgivable Loan that was issued this week. Flipped Out Furniture Received a \$25,000 SBFL from the City.
- 2nd & Mulberry Roundabout Meeting: The following is a brief summary of the Roundabout meeting at the Library. Just as a reminder, the City Council agreed to allow the City Engineer to add an additional 10% to the working days at last night's council meeting. We are all committed to working with the downtown property owners and businesses on both this project and the forthcoming 2nd Street project (likely a 2 year project).
  - There were approximately 20 people in attendance. City staff included Brian, Jim, Pat, Kevin and Council Member Spread. Brian has a sign-up sheet that was distributed at the beginning of the meeting. I introduced myself, the Contractor (Jamie Heuer) and City staff and explained the purpose of the meeting.
  - Jim Edgmond discussed the property acquisition/demolition issues that are in different stages of development. Todd Bermel (HNI) gave an update regarding the status of the HNI building. (Please note: Staff is meeting with HNI to review the transfer of the property, timing for emptying out the building and demolition next week.)

- The real heart of today's discussion focused on the contractor's schedule. Business merchants do not want this project to begin until January. From October thru December is their busiest season, and traffic interruption/confusion at 2nd & Mulberry has the potential to negatively impact their business. Comments about the 2nd Street Streetscape project were also made. The business owners acknowledged that construction projects are necessary, and they do understand these improvements are intended to help their businesses.
- After listening to their concerns and providing explanations about both projects the following conclusions were reached:
  1. The Contractor and City staff will reconsider the initial schedule of the Roundabout and determine how best to issue a Notice to Proceed after January 1, 2020. (Please note that last night's amendment helps to address this issue.)
  2. The contractor has 70 working days to completed the work at present.
  3. This allows HNI more time to get their building appraised and for demolition.
  4. The City Council is scheduled to receive an update on the 2nd Street Streetscape Project on September 19th. A meeting with the CBD merchants will be set either before or near that date to provide a summation of the current project (around 50% completion).
  5. This project is scheduled for bid in December 2019.
  6. Brian has a CBD contact that will help in notifying merchants going forward. As such, another meeting date was not set. If one is needed it will be at 9:00 a.m. at the Library. (or 8:00am - to be confirmed).
  7. I will ask others who were in attendance to add to these notes as needed. Rhill

### **FLIPPED OUT FURNITURE RECEIVES \$25,000 SBFL FROM CITY**

*Repurposing furniture with good bones store relocating to Downtown Muscatine*

**MUSCATINE, Iowa** – A successful furniture business is moving from Davenport to Downtown Muscatine and received a \$25,000 Small Business Forgivable Loan (SBFL) from the City of Muscatine Community Development Department to help with the relocation effort.

“Flipped Out Furniture”, owned by Rebekah Despeghe and Josh Terry, will be closing their Davenport location and moving to 225 E. 2nd Street, Muscatine, with a Mid-October opening. Community Development Director Jodi Royal Goodwin and City Planner Lindsay Whitson presented the check to Despeghe and Terry Thursday (Sept. 5).

It is a move closer to home for the Nichols residents who also view Downtown Muscatine as the ideal location for their business.

“Flipped Out Furniture” will use the SBFL funds to rehabilitate the space to give customers a more historical downtown Muscatine feel when they walk into a shop that will showcase repurposed and reclaimed furniture with an antique old world feel.

“We feel the connection between our business and Downtown Muscatine,” Terry said. “It is historical but updated. We have walked up and down the street and talked with shop owners who have made us feel very welcomed. It is a great feeling.”

Despeghel said that the brick and mortar store in Davenport has been open for about four years but they have been repurposing furniture for five years.

“I remember driving down a street with my dad when we came across this old dresser lying by the side of the road,” Deseghel said. “We loaded it up, took it home, and began to tweak it. A neighbor saw what we were doing with the piece and wanted to buy it. A year later we opened the store.”

The store takes old pieces of furniture that still have “good bones” and repurposes them with a new, updated style.

“We offer unique home décor, antiques, and furniture to fit all décor styles and budgets,” Despeghel said. “We also build farmhouse tables, benches, sofa tables, coffee tables, etc.”

The goal and mission of the business is to keep good, quality future that has plenty of life left in them out of the dump.

“We believe our planet is a sacred place and that up-cycled furniture is the best,” Despeghel said. “We also take our customers outdated existing furniture and give it a makeover for them so they will love it forever.”

“Flipped Out Furniture” has built a large clientele in Davenport and an equally large customer base in Muscatine.

“Our Davenport customers have indicated that they will travel to Muscatine to visit our store just as our Muscatine customers did when they came to the Davenport location,” Despeghel said.

“We are excited to have our customers come and visit our store along with the other shops and restaurants in Downtown Muscatine.”

Thompson Trucking, Inc., Skinny’s Barbeque, Bosch Pest Control, Bridge Side Pub LLC, and Wine Nutz have received SBFL funds so far this year.



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**SMALL BUSINESS FORGIVABLE LOAN PROGRAM** - The City of Muscatine offers Small Business Forgivable Loans for building improvements and startup cost associated with the creation of a new business or to existing businesses significantly expanding into a new market, product or service. Businesses can obtain a loan for up to \$25,000 at a term of five years with 20 percent of the original loan forgiven annually at the anniversary of the origination of the loan. Funds are allocated up to \$15,000 for startup cost and up to \$10,000 for code compliance.

The City has allocated \$100,000 in funding annually. Funds will be awarded to qualifying businesses based on availability of funds.

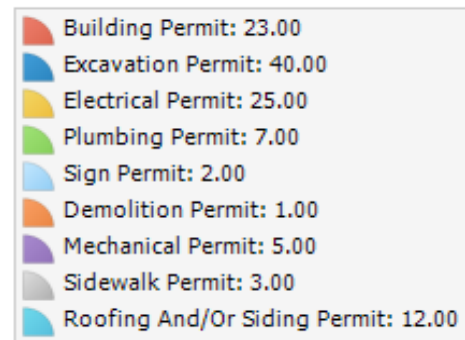
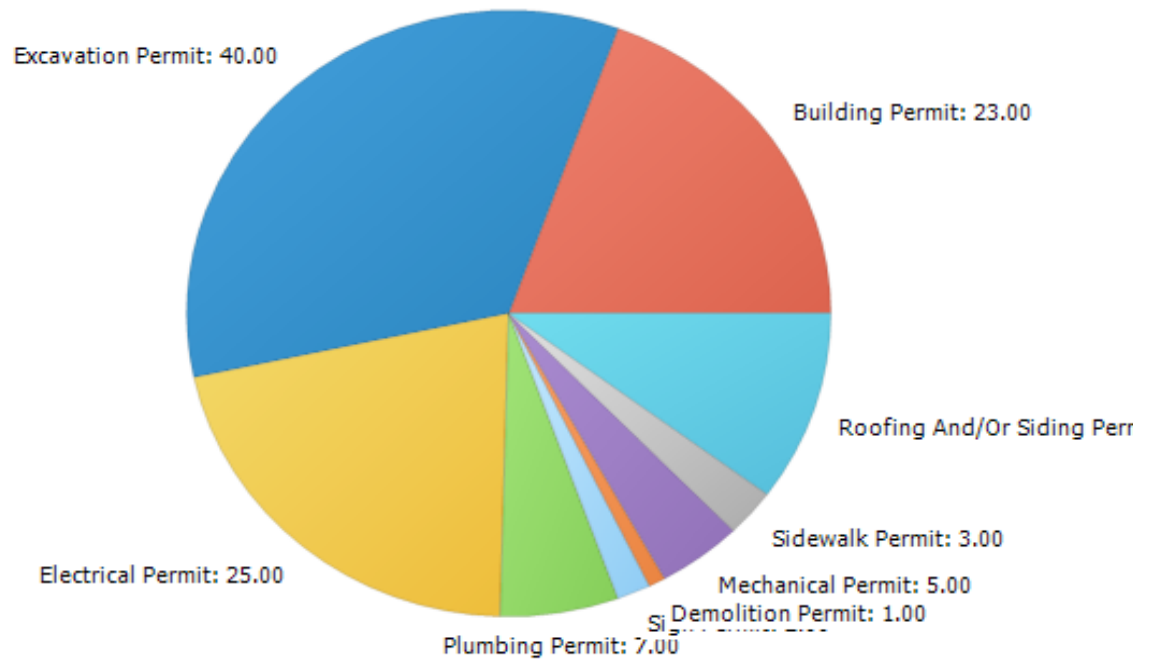
