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City Administrator Report to Mayor & City Council

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Report:

1. Fire Station: We continue to press for replacement of the cracked panels at the fire station. Our General Contractor is looking to get an independent firm to review the issues prior to replacement. This to provide further protection should they need to use a different sub-contractor to complete the panels. The present sub-contractor, though, has not refused to proceed. We are awaiting word, but have been clear on our stance.
2. Meetings: Joint City/School/MPW/MCC/Trinity monthly meeting, National Guard/Reserve Center Grand Opening, Chamber Board of Directors, MPW Lean Meeting, Economic Development Committee, City/School Meeting (Sports Programming)
3. Trail: We will plan to hold a ribbon cutting along the new trail next week. We are targeting Wednesday or Thursday at 10am at the end of Ford Avenue (Back by Bandag).
4. In-Depths: Upcoming In-Depth sessions include: GIS sign inventory, salary/performance continued discussion, CSO and debt service (w/PFM)
5. Musser Train & Cedar Street: Staff continues to work with Bi-State to see if we can reallocate unused federal funds to the Musser Trail (\$100,000+/-) and to Cedar Street (\$900,000+/-). When we have conformation of either project funding we will certainly let you know.
