WEEKLY UPDATE:

2. WPCP: Jon Koch wanted to let everyone know that we are in our new facility. The Water Pollution Control Plant will have a open house later this spring with plant tours that include a tour of the laboratory. The lab is running in the new facility and still in the process of running new tests, Certification Officer inspections, and routine testing. The plant staff helped us start the move the first week of December, and the last items were finally moved out of the old laboratory this past week. The WPCP lab is certified to test for septic system discharge samples for those who live in the county and are required to have this testing completed. Residents can stop by the front office and pick up a test kit.
3. Bi-State: Attached please find a copy of the Commission in Review for March 2015.
4. CSO: Some additional information on the CSO project - the ravine capacity is around 376,824 cubic yards. Bill Haag prepared this estimate of fill capacity for the ravine and it will be a great asset that we can utilized over the next 15 years or so to reduce our costs. Also attached is the most recent (Draft) concept for subdividing the ravine into 10 building lots. All 10 of these lots could be built on with out the further extension of public infrastructure this layout also preserves the ability to sell off the lots individually or in bulk to a developer. Additionally this subdivision can help avoid another Iowa Field situation by making it very clear from the beginning that the City has no long term intention of hanging onto this land as open space/parkland.
5. Cemetery: Please see the attached draft agreement for the Cemetery Steps project should it move forward.

The CP was very receptive and we will look to finalizing a preliminary MOU that lays out the next steps. The CP will be a key partner in the Mississippi Drive project.

 - EA/4(f) – Documents are currently in FHWA review process. The review process may be delayed somewhat due to staff losses in the local FHWA office. Matt Oetker will follow up next week with Mike LaPietra to get an update on progress.
 - Section 106 Process – Libby is awaiting MOA comments from FHWA. The letter sent by the City's Attorney has gone to FHWA general council in DC for comment. The FHWA response is expected to come back through Mike LaPietra. There is no time table for this reply.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Snow & Ice Control:

Snow & Ice Control Report 2014-15: Please see the following summary of snow and ice control operations for this past winter provided by DPW Director Hill.

The following is a summation of the 2014/2015 Snow & Ice Control Operation:

1. The number of Snow & Ice Control Events = 14
 - November = 2
 - December = 0
 - January = 9
 - February = 2
 - March = 1
2. Our records for snow accumulation = 35". Note: The "average" accumulation is 30" - 36". '14/'15 would be considered an average winter.
3. Equipment:
 - a. Our mainline snow/ice equipment held up well with NO major breakdowns.
 - b. This is the second year we have used the "under body" (belly) plow. Again, we had success using this special featured equipment and should have two trucks outfitted with the under body plow for '15/'16.
 - c. We did not have an opportunity to try the new wing plow because it was not attached until mid-March. However, we will have three trucks outfitted with the wing plow for '15/'16.
4. Manpower:

- a. This is our weakest area. However, all Roadway Maintenance Equipment Operators were available this winter.
- b. Because we have more equipment than manpower we may consider using a qualified TEMP employee in '15/'16.
- c. The Collection & Drainage crew did help considerably this winter as well as Vehicle Maintenance staff (when they were not busy repairing equipment).

5. LEAN:

- a. The Pre-Event and Post-Event meetings continue to be an excellent forum to discuss issues that plague the snow/ice operation. Communication between the Public Safety personnel (PD & MUSCOM) and Equipment Operators was better but not good enough. More effort needs to be focused on this problem.
- b. One efficiency improvement from last year was focusing towing efforts on specific zones rather than the shotgun approach used in '13/'14.

6. Central Business District:

- a. The Pre-Event meetings helped with the communication between PD's effort to post the CBD for "No Parking" in advance of cleanup efforts and the CBD Contractor (J. Brauns).
- b. We need to better define the CBD for Snow Emergency purposes. Since the CBD is not included in a Snow Emergency, specific "boundaries" are necessary for ticketing purposes.
- c. The CBD Contractor (Brauns) was used four (4) times this year at a cost of \$55,955.

7. Snow Emergency Declarations:

- a. Snow Emergencies were declared two (2) times:
 - i. January 5, 2015 --- 288 tickets written, 0 vehicles towed
 - ii. February 1, 2015 --- 117 tickets written, 11 vehicles towed
- b. Public education regarding removal of vehicles from the street continues to improve. We are witnessing more cooperation even when NO snow emergency is declared.

8. Materials Used:

- a. Salt = 1802 tons
- b. Sand = 434 tons
- c. bottom Ash = minimal use in alleys only

9. Plow Jockey Problems:

- a. The City code does not provide direction on this.
- b. It is an on-going problem - all winter
- c. Something needs to be done about this going forward
 - 1. Notify businesses
 - 2. Letter from City Attorney
 - 3. Registration of individuals/businesses who provide this service

10. Other Incidental Comments:

- a. Received our usual complaints
- b. Equipment Operators were involved in 2-3 small accidents
- c. Our mirrors on the equipment take a beating during snow/ice operations
- d. Filed charges on one (1) citizen for making threatening remarks

11. Suggestions from EO/Administrative Staff:

- a. R. Howell attended the Sate APWA meeting in Des Moines (March 25-27) and participated in a discussion regarding Snow/Ice control.
- b. A presentation was made by Council Bluffs about their program and Randy has a copy of this powerpoint.
- c. Council Bluffs will provide a good measure for us as we gauge areas of improvement.
- d. R. Howell and I will show this to our Equipment Operators within the next couple of weeks and again in the Fall so everyone can learn and offer suggestions to make the operation better. Others are certainly welcome to attend.
- e. Compliments to the Muscatine Police Department, MUSCOM and Muscatine School District for participating in the Pre & Post-Event meetings.

Without the efforts and support of the Equipment Operators, Supervisors, Administrative Staff, Police Department, City Administrator and the City Council our Snow & Ice Control Operation would not be as successful as it is. Every year we get a little better. Winter is a difficult time for all the members of the community, but patience and cooperation on the part of the public and improved efficiency by Public Works staff is needed to get through those "long, cold, lonely days and nights".




I-74 Bridge on Track for Construction

Doug Rick of the Iowa Department of Transportation (DOT) and Rebecca Marruffo of the Illinois DOT provided an update on the I-74 Mississippi River Bridge Corridor Project. The Interstate 74 Bridge Corridor project involves the replacement of the I-74

Bridge and over six miles of corridor improvements. It is in need of reconstruction due to crashes, recurring congestion, and significant maintenance. The bridge itself is functionally obsolete with no shoulders. The Iowa bound span was built in 1935 and the Illinois bound span in 1959.



There are two projects currently underway that will prepare the streets in downtown Bettendorf and Moline for the new bridge. Grant Street in Bettendorf will be reconstructed over the next two years. During this time State Street will remain open, and two lanes of Grant Street will be maintained.

In Moline, the River Drive project between 19th and 23rd streets, which began in fall 2014, will be completed in June 2015, and River Drive will be reopened. There will also be work on the I-74 Bridge itself this year, but day time lane closures will be avoided until late summer when projects on the Centennial and Government Bridges are finished.

The number one transportation priority in the Bi-State Region is the replacement of the I-74 Bridge. The I-74 Mississippi River Bridge Corridor project is positioned to receive significant additional federal funding. The project is included in the Transportation Improvement Programs for both the Iowa and Illinois DOTs. All National Environmental Protection Act requirements are complete, and final design of the central section will be completed in 2015.

Pre-construction elements of the project along with right-of-way acquisition and demolition are nearing completion. Funding could be available through a new multi-year surface transportation bill that provides long-term certainty and increases funding for transportation infrastructure including a discretionary fund for construction ready bridge projects. The work of the entire federal delegation to previously obtain over 88 million dollars is greatly appreciated by all Quad Cities leaders.


The I-74 Bridge Corridor project has been value engineered to reduce costs and the construction period from 8 to 3.5 years or less. Plans for the Iowa portion of the bridge are 100% complete and are nearing completion for the Illinois portion of the project, which will be completed this summer. Elements of the project including the Lincoln Road overpass and the interchange at 53rd Street have already been finished. Property purchases have been completed in Iowa, and all properties that required total buyouts are done in Illinois. Illinois DOT will be continuing with partial property buyouts over the next two years.

The reconstructed I-74 Bridge will have increased protection for seismic occurrences and barge collisions and is being built to last 100 years. The reconstructed I-74 Bridge will have full shoulders allowing for emergency vehicle access in the event of an incident. It will also include a rare interstate multi-purpose trail along the downstream side with Mississippi River Trail access on each side and an elevator in Bettendorf.

Construction on the project will begin in the river in late 2017 and all of 2018. The approaches will be constructed in 2019 and 2020 with the old bridge set for demolition in 2021. The total cost for the entire six-mile corridor is \$1.25 billion, which includes \$250 million in reserves and the \$88 million already spent on engineering, ROW acquisition, demolition, and portions of the project corridor previously completed. The remaining costs for the central bridge section are estimated at approximately \$750 million in the year of expenditure. While the project is listed in current Iowa and Illinois DOT Transportation Improvement Programs, additional discretionary funding would be used for the final year of bridge construction, FY 2021. In addition, the northern section of the corridor from Middle Road to 53rd Street is an independent project to be constructed following the bridge completion. The northern section has not been funded and has a cost of \$115 million.



City of Muscatine
Greenwood Cemetery Steps Project Agreement

It is hereby agreed by and between the City of Muscatine, Iowa hereinafter referred to as City and Friends of Greenwood Cemetery hereinafter referred to as F.G.C. as follows:

1. That the City and F.G.C. agree that this agreement provides guidelines that are for the “Cemetery Step Project”. In the event of site deterioration and/or local or state changes in regulations or if the project parameters change there may be additional requirements.
2. That F.G.C. agrees to obtain all necessary licenses, permits, and certificates, as required by Federal Law, State Law, or Local Ordinance, at F.G.C.’s expense.
3. That F.G.C. agrees to assume full and absolute responsibility for, and to defend, hold harmless and indemnify, the City and its Officers, Employees, and Agents, for any and all claims, damages and losses in any way resulting from the maintenance, operation, or use of the steps or immediate area around the steps. A maintenance endowment shall be in place prior to the start of the project.
4. That prior to the start of this project F.G.C. shall file a certificate of insurance with the City, F.G.C. will provide a fifteen (15) day notice of cancellation in writing, naming the City as additional insured. F.G.C. shall purchase or provide for liability insurance in the amount of at least one million (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence and two million (\$2,000,000.00) aggregate for bodily injury and property damage claims. Additionally, the contractor shall furnish a maintenance bond subject to the City’s approval.
5. That F.G.C. agrees to observe all laws of the State of Iowa, all Ordinances of the City of Muscatine, Iowa and all Federal laws applicable to the project including A.D.A. compliance where applicable.
6. That F.G.C. agrees not to assign this agreement without the expressed written consent from the City.
7. That F.G.C. may not make permanent changes or improvements to the project area without the expressed written consent of the City, and said improvements shall become the property of the City without compensation to F.G.C.
8. That F.G.C. will provide to the City and update as needed the F.G.C. BYLAWS and Organizational Structure including the appointing of a single point of contact to the City.
9. That F.G.C. will provide to the City a list with values of contributors and contractors working on or donating to this project.


10. That F.G.C. will provide to the City a project concept plan with a cost estimate that is supported by current relevant engineering standards.
11. A phased project approach will be allowed as long as the initial phase addresses all safety concerns of the project including but not limited to handrails, step deterioration and water drainage crossing the steps. City Staff will approve the specifications for each phase. Funding and in kind services must be in place and in writing to the City prior to the start of the first or any phase.
12. The City will inspect each phase or component during and prior to acceptance of the project.
13. The project will need to include an approved system for closing the steps during bad weather or should the steps fall in disrepair or become dangerous i.e. snow, ice, fallen trees, after dark and during winter.
14. The project will need to go through a City Site Plan Review.
15. The project shall be completed by _____ or the City will remove the remaining steps.
16. That the City may terminate this agreement by providing written notice if F.G.C. does not perform the terms and conditions of this agreement.
17. That F.G.C. shall not permit any of the following practices:
 - a. To discharge from employment or refuse to hire any individual because of their race, creed, color, national origin, religion, age, sex, marital status, political affiliation, or disability.
 - b. To discriminate against any individual in the terms, conditions, or privileges of employment because of their race, creed, color, national origin, religion, sex, marital status, political affiliation, or disability.
 - c. To discriminate against any individual in the performance of any obligation or the extension of services under this agreement because of their race, creed, color, national origin, religion, age, sex, marital status, political affiliation, or disability.







1. The attached schedule has been developed to track Iowa Department of Transportation (DOT), Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) and other agency review periods and project progress.
2. IaDOT and FHWA are not obligated/committed by law to complete reviews within a maximum duration. Review periods have been determined from past project experiences. Actual review periods may vary depending upon individual reviewers and agency situations.
3. The typical review periods utilized to determine durations are listed below:
 - IaDOT 1st review – 3 weeks + 2 days
 - IaDOT 2nd review – 2 weeks + 2 days
 - IaDOT transfer back to FHWA after FHWA review + comments incorporated – 1 day
 - FHWA 1st review – 3 weeks
 - FHWA 2nd review – 3 weeks
 - Legal Sufficiency review – 45 days (no second review)
3. Task durations are conservative for use in planning. Stanley Consultants team will push to expedite the schedule as much as possible and where applicable. It is anticipated that the durations may shorten and as this occurs the schedule will be adjusted accordingly.
4. For schedule development, it has been assumed that when comments are received from reviewing agency, the comments are adequately accommodated/incorporated into the second document submittal and the reviewing agency concurs following second review.
