**WHEREAS, the United Nations Association of the USA has declared “Global Goals, Local Leaders” as its theme to recognize local efforts to champion one or more of the Global Goals, for the 2017 United Nations Day commemoration; and**

**WHEREAS, the City of Muscatine is committed to educating and mobilizing our local communities to build a stronger network of global citizens and leaders to create a more prosperous, safe, just, and sustainable world for all; and**

**WHEREAS, the citizens of Muscatine should participate in all activities related to UN Day.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, I Diana Broderson, Mayor of the City of Muscatine, officially proclaim October 24, 2018 as United Nations Day.**
