Re: Request to Issue Purchase Order for One Ton Dump Truck

Introduction:

The Collection and Drainage department has budgeted in FY 2019/2020 funds to replace a 2010 one ton dump truck. This truck will be transferred to the Water Treatment Plant to replace a 1986 one ton flatbed truck which will be sold.

Background:

The truck being purchased/replaced is used in the day to day operations of the Collection and Drainage division of Public Works. This truck is used to haul materials, tools and equipment needed for the repair and maintenance of Muscatine's storm and sanitary sewer collection systems.

Bids were opened on September 12, 2019 and are as follows;

1. Deery Brothers, Iowa City, \$51,539.00
2. Krieger Motors, Muscatine, \$49,486.00
3. McGrath Auto, Cedar Rapids, \$56,562.00
4. McGrath Commercial, Cedar Rapids, \$51,506.00
5. Krieger Auto Group, Muscatine, \$57,485.00
6. Stew Hansen, DesMoines, \$50,291.00
7. Dewy Ford, Ankeny, \$50,803.00

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the vehicle purchase be awarded to low bidder, Krieger Motors of Muscatine for the price of \$49,486.00 for a 2020 Chevrolet 3500 four wheel drive dump truck with stainless steel dump bed and tool boxes. \$45,000.00 has been budgeted for this purchase in FY20. With an unforeseen increase in material and transportation costs at budget time, the department will be able to save in other areas of the FY20 budget to allow for the bid being over the estimated amount.
