INTRODUCTION: Included with this memo is a resolution approving the contract and bond from Hy-Brand Industrial Contractors LTD for the renovation of Bond and Schley Pumping Stations.

BACKGROUND: Stanley will prepare a conformed project manual (contract) and send a Notice of Award letter to the contractor requesting them to sign the contract, provide insurance and bond certificates.

After the Contractor receives the NOA (Notice of Award) the contractor will sign the contracts and return them to Stanley Consultants. When we get them back, the City (the mayor) will sign the contract.
