INTRODUCTION:

The City of Muscatine periodically declares excess property as surplus in order to make it available to the public for purchase.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Muscatine is using an on-line auction service known as Public Surplus to dispose of property and equipment. This method of sale supplants the one-time live auction service which resulted in decreasing revenue due to lack of interest and a smaller clientele of interested buyers. The city has used Public Surplus several times.

RECOMMENDATION/RATIONALE:

Public Works personnel have worked with other city departments to compile a list of items to be disposed through Public Surplus. The city places a minimum bid on several of the items to ensure we receive fair compensation for the products. We recommend the city council declare the list of vehicles and equipment as submitted by Vehicle and Equipment Services Supervisor Gale Fry (memo dated August 31, 2012) as surplus property.
