SUMMER PROGRAM REGISTRATION

Summer Program Registration - Important: Pre-registration is required (except as noted). Registration for all summer programs will begin on Tuesday, May 5, 2020, unless otherwise noted. All program registrations may be mailed in or dropped off.

You can now register for programs online! Be the FIRST in line when you register ONLINE! Registration is available at <https://apm.activecommunities.com/muscatine/Home>. It's EASY! Whether you are at home or the office, it's now quick and convenient to register for your favorite activities and programs on our website.

Registrations will be accepted at the Muscatine Parks and Recreation Department office in the lower level of City Hall, located on the corner of Third and Sycamore. Registration hours, Monday through Friday, are 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.

FEES - All fees are payable at time of registration. Checks should be made payable to: City of Muscatine. Please do not send cash in the mail. Visa and MasterCard are accepted.

NON-RESIDENT FEES - City of Muscatine residents (persons living inside the Muscatine city limits), through their property taxes, contribute to the operation of the Parks and Recreation Department. The non-resident fees are assessed to our non-resident participants so they contribute to the

overall financing of the Department on a more equitable basis with our residents. Recreation program non-resident fees are figured at double the fee not to exceed \$5.00. We're here to serve you, and we want to be fair. We ask for your cooperation. Thank you!

Note: Non-residents on Parks and Recreation sports league rosters pay a flat \$5.00 for each roster they are signed on.

REFUNDS – No refunds will be given after the registration period is closed for an activity unless the Parks and Recreation Department cancels the entire activity. In the event that a program day is not held, a partial fee credit or refund may be considered upon request.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY - All outdoor programs may be held as scheduled if it is not storming at scheduled starting time. Adverse weather conditions may cause the postponement of some activities. Please contact the DEPARTMENT HOTLINE 563-263-0241 for current program information. You can also receive cancellation alerts via text message or email by visiting the Notify Me link at <http://www.muscatineiowa.gov>.

FUNDRAISING ON PUBLIC PROPERTY - Fundraising by profit oriented individuals, businesses, groups, and/or organizations on public grounds or at public facilities is prohibited. Fundraising activities by non-profit oriented individuals, businesses, groups and/or organizations will be considered on an individual basis.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

DIAMOND RESERVATIONS - Diamond scheduling for games, tournaments, camps and clinics may be requested on a one day less than a year basis. Exceptions will be made for national, regional, and state events. Groups wishing to make reservations for practice sessions may do so as early as the Friday prior to the week of the requested practice. Each team will be allowed a maximum of two (2) 1 ½ hour practice times each week. Diamond reservations for a prepared diamond must be made by 11:00 a.m. of the preceding day, normal business hours, Monday - Friday. Unprepared diamond reservation fees are \$20.00 for residents and \$30.00 for non-residents. Prepared diamond reservation fees are \$30.00 for residents and \$50.00 for non-residents. These fees will be charged to all non-league/association requests.

PARK SHELTER USAGE - Shelters are available to the public on a first come, first serve basis. A fee of \$30.00 for residents/\$40.00 for non-residents is charged for shelter reservations. Advance shelter reservations may be made one day less than a year prior to the desired date. Phone reservations are accepted by calling 563-263-0241 with a credit card payment.

FACILITY REFUND - Refunds will be considered if it is requested at least 30 days prior to the reservation. Requests for refunds must be made in writing.

SPEAKER'S BUREAU - We would like to encourage your club or group to invite one of our staff members to a future meeting. Let us keep you

informed as to our goals and objectives, as well as what new programs are being planned and how your tax dollars are being spent for Parks and Recreation opportunities within the community.

REQUEST FOR PROGRAMS AND VOLUNTEERS - Persons interested in programs and activities not presented in this brochure or who feel qualified in a specific area of teaching, supervising or volunteering, please contact the Parks and Recreation Department office.

COOPERATION - The Muscatine Parks and Recreation Department works closely with other public and private agencies. From time to time, activities may be co-sponsored in an effort to provide comprehensive leisure time pursuits for the entire community. The cooperation of the Muscatine Community School District is indispensable to the Department in providing their many facilities for various programs.

MUSCATINE DOG PARK

The Muscatine Dog Park is an off-leash community dog park located at 600 South Houser Street across from Kent Stein Park. Site features include a half-acre shy and timid dog area, a 1.5-acre area for small dogs, and a three-acre enclosure for large dogs. Park amenities include an Entrance Plaza with picnic tables, benches, water fountains with dog bowls, and shelters in each of the three enclosures. The Muscatine Dog Park is open daily from dawn until dusk unless closed for maintenance.

PERMIT REQUIRED

A permit/dog tag must be displayed while using the park including annual membership pass or daily pass. To purchase an annual membership pass or daily pass please visit https://apm.activecommunities.com/muscatine/Activity_Search/2463 or stop by the Muscatine Parks and Recreation Department office. Annual passes run January through December.

FEES

Annual Pass: \$15.00 per dog per household

Daily Pass: \$5.00 per dog per household

DOG PARK USAGE REGULATIONS

- Dogs must be in view and under control of their handler at all times.
- All handlers must be at least 16 years of age and have a leash in hand at all times.
- Children under the age of 16 must be supervised by an adult.
- Handlers are REQUIRED to pick up and dispose of their dog's waste.
- No more than two dogs per handler.
- Dogs CANNOT be left alone in the dog park.
- Handlers must stop their dog from digging and must fill any holes their dog creates.
- Dogs that consistently exhibit dominant aggressive behavior, that regularly do not come when called, that play too rough, and/or that cannot control their barking must be removed from the park immediately and without debate. Multiple violations of this rule may result in permanent ban from the dog park.
- Water is provided at the dog park. Please do not bring in water bowls or leave toys behind as they have been proven to potentially spread disease.
- All dogs must have a valid rabies vaccination tag. (Iowa Code §351.35)
- All dogs belonging to City of Muscatine residents must have a valid city license tag. (Muscatine City Code Section 6-9-2)

SEASON PASSES - Season passes are honored for open swim at the Muscatine Aquatic Center. The family pass rate applies to anyone in the family listed as a dependent on the latest IRS tax return. Unauthorized use of a swim pass could result in the loss of the pass for the entire season.

POOL RENTALS - The Muscatine Aquatic Center is available to rent outside of scheduled hours for birthday parties or other events. The Parks and Recreation Department will provide the lifeguards. The fee is \$150.00 (\$175.00 for non-residents) for up to 50 people. Rentals are scheduled in 1 ½ hour increments. If you wish to have additional time, or more than 50 people, additional charges are incurred. The Multi-Purpose room at the Aquatic Center is also available for rent for \$50.00 (\$75.00 for non-residents) for a 2 hour time period and may be reserved either during open swim times or outside of open swim hours. Call the Parks and Recreation office at 563-263-0241 for more information, or to schedule a rental.

To enroll in Swim Lessons, the participant must have successfully completed or be able to perform the skills of the preceding course. Skills will be checked on the first day of class and participants may be shifted to another class based on their skill level. Children must be 6 years of age to participate in swim lessons. **All classes will be held at the Muscatine Aquatic Center.**





Muscatine Soccer Complex

The City of Muscatine invites you to the Muscatine Soccer Complex, which has been recognized by the Sports Turf Managers Association as "Best Soccer Facility." The original complex is a 39-acre, 3.8-million-dollar soccer facility that features eight (8) full-sized state-of-the-art premiere soccer fields. In 2020, a nearly 1.5-million-dollar addition resulted in 17 acres and four (4) lighted fields. Two of the eight original fields are internationally sized, lighted, and contain amended soils. The complex is fully equipped including concessions, media center, restroom facility, and parking area.

The Muscatine Soccer Complex plays host to events sponsored by national, state and local associations, involving participants of all ages. Camps, clinics, games and tournaments are welcome. Complex usage may be requested on a one day less than a year basis. Exceptions will be made for national, regional and state events.

SPECIAL FACILITIES

Kent Stein Park

Kent Stein Park contains a total of 66 acres and adjoins an 11-acre slough. The park facilities include nine (9) lighted softball diamonds, eight (8) lighted baseball diamonds, and nine (9) lighted horseshoe courts. Other amenities in the park include restroom facilities, two concession stands, picnic areas and fishing in the slough.

Diamond scheduling for games, tournaments, camps and clinics may be requested on a one day less than a year basis. Exceptions will be made for national, regional, and state events.

Pearl City Station

Pearl City Station is located on the riverfront and is available to the public for meetings, reunions, wedding receptions, and other non-profit events during the months of March through November. This building must be reserved in advance and the fee will depend on the day/time used and the use of alcohol. The building is equipped with restrooms, tables, and chairs. Pearl City Station is ventilated and has radiating heat (no air-conditioning). Reservations can be made with the Parks and Recreation office.

Riverview Center

The Riverview Center is located on the riverfront and is available to the public to rent for wedding receptions, family reunions, class reunions, meetings and other non-profit events year round. Some of the features of the Riverview Center include heating/air conditioning, accessible elevator and accessible restrooms, catering kitchen, 15-foot deck on two sides overlooking the river, and approximately 22 tables and 175 chairs.

This building must be reserved in advance and the fee will depend on day/time used and the use of alcohol. Reservations can be made with the Parks and Recreation office.

Muscatine Municipal Boat Harbor

The City of Muscatine operates the Municipal Boat Harbor located by Riverside Park on the mighty Mississippi. The harbor has 8 slips for houseboats and 52 slips for smaller, pleasure and/or speed boats. There are slips available for rent for the current season. Transient slips are available. Gas, diesel and pump-out service are also available at the Municipal Marina located in the channel just upriver from the docks. For more information on slip rental or fueling hours, please call 563-263-0241.

Weed Park

Weed Park covers a total of 64 acres, including a three (3) acre lagoon. The park is home to the Muscatine Aquatic Center, and has fishing for children, a rose garden and zoo garden, playground equipment, bandstand, restroom facilities, concession stand, parking areas, picnic areas, seven (7) picnic shelters, eight (8) tennis courts (four lighted), and three (3) sand pit volleyball courts.

Greenwood Cemetery

As a municipally owned and operated facility, Greenwood responds to many burial requests including cremations, the financially indigent, military personnel and children. Greenwood Cemetery also offers a 104 niche columbarium. Single and double depths are available.

Greenwood Cemetery contains 80 acres of well-maintained lawns, stately trees and historical memorials. It is located in a beautiful residential area overlooking the Mississippi River Valley, and is a non-profit, non-sectarian cemetery with a tradition of caring since 1843. The Greenwood Cemetery Chapel was entered into the National Register of Historical Places with the State Historical Society of Iowa in 2002.

Our professional, courteous staff is available to assist the family with location and genealogy as well as pre-planning. We invite you to visit Greenwood Cemetery and personally experience the timeless beauty of this distinctive facility.

Muscatine Disc Golf Course

The City of Muscatine has an 18-hole disc golf course that is located in Fuller Park on Cedar Street near the bypass. This course accommodates players of all skill levels with wide open shots for the first time recreational player and more difficult holes for those who are seeking more of a challenge. There is no fee to play this course. The course is equipped with ample parking, restrooms, signage and benches throughout.

Muscatine Parks and Recreation Department Playgrounds

The Muscatine Parks and Recreation Department is home to over 45,000 square feet of colorful, modular, state of the art playgrounds. There are twelve playgrounds in eleven select City neighborhood parks. Each playground is uniquely designed utilizing play equipment appropriate for a wide age range. Poured-in-place rubberized safety surfacing, which is one of the industry's safest known play surfaces, is under each playground and allows for expanded seasonal playground usage.

Playgrounds can be found at the following park sites: Brook Street Park, Eversmeyer Park, Oak Park, Lucas Park, Fuller Park, Longview Park, Musser Park, Taylor Park, Fourth Street Park, Riverfront Area and Weed Park.

Mississippi Mist

The Mississippi Mist is a beautiful water feature located on the Muscatine Riverfront. It is an interactive splash pad with a riverboat smokestack themed center jet that shoots water up to 30 feet in the air. The programmed water display features around the base sprout up at different intervals and include four mist jets and four outer cannons that shoot water into the center. The water feature is lit and creates a spectacular night show. The hours of operation are from 8:00am to 10:00pm. The splash pad is not attended by a lifeguard and children must be accompanied by adults.

Muscatine Skate Park

PARK HOURS: 5:00AM – 11:00PM

The Muscatine Skate Park is located at Musser Park. This park offers the Muscatine Community an opportunity to use their skateboards, roller blades and BMX bikes in an environment where they can improve their skills in a place designed for that purpose. The park includes parking for up to 27 vehicles, a flat track and a fenced area with a 100x100 foot stunt area and a 90x50 foot in-line hockey rink. The obstacle/stunt area has a concrete surface with a variety of steel ramps. Lights will shut off automatically at 11:00pm.


