One of five A.T.E. locations offline as court case proceeds

Red light, speeding enforcement continue at four other Muscatine locations

MUSCATINE, Iowa – An Automated Traffic Enforcement (A.T.E.) program is being utilized by the City of Muscatine at five locations. The system detects red light and speeding violations at the intersections. A recent court decision has been rendered that is prohibiting the system's usage at the intersection of Highway 61 and University Drive. An appeal is being made by the City of the decision, but the camera equipment will not be operational until a verdict is made regarding the appeal. The court action does not effect or involve the remaining intersections that are monitored by the A.T.E. system. As a result, the remaining sections will be enforced without change.
