WEST HILL SEWER PROJECT MOVES TO EAST 5TH STREET

Work around 4th Street Park in last phases as work begins on East 5th Street

MUSCATINE, Iowa – The West Hill Sewer Separation Project is wrapping up work around the 4th Street Park area and beginning work on East 5th Street according to Steve Dalbey, inspector for the City of Muscatine.

Haggerty Earthworks has completed all sewer work in the 4th Street Park area and has moved equipment to East 5th Street. That street is now closed from Cedar to Sycamore streets. Paving contractor Heuer Construction is preparing West 4th Street between Cherry Street and the park for paving along with Broadway on the west side of the park back to Cherry Lane.

Heuer Construction has completed concrete work on Broadway between the #3 and #4 alleys and from the #4 alley up West 4th Street to Cherry Lane on the north side of the park. West 4th Street between Locust Street and the park, and Broadway between the #3 and #4 alleys will be opened up to local traffic incrementally as the paving and finishing work are accomplished.

Sewer work on East 5th Street is beginning between Cedar and Sycamore Streets with the block now closed for underground sewer work. The intersections with East 5th at Cedar Street and at Sycamore Street are open for the present time. As the work moves up East 5th Street through the Sycamore and Iowa intersections, the street and intersections will be closed.
