

September 19, 2017**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE****FIRST RECONSTRUCTED SECTION OF CLEVELAND STREET OPEN***Second phase now underway; asphalt overlay work continues on Lincoln Boulevard*

MUSCATINE, Iowa – The first section of Cleveland Street to be repaved has been opened and work has begun on the second phase of the Cleveland Street Reconstruction Project. All-American Concrete opened up the Cleveland Street intersection with Park Avenue and Frontage Road Tuesday (Sept. 19). The second phase will continue from the end of the reconstruction of first phase to just east of Coventry Lane.

The 2017 Asphalt Overlay project is also continuing with work on McArthur Street and Washington Street completed. Lincoln Boulevard is closed Tuesday (Sept. 19) for asphaltting with Illowa Investment Inc., also planning to put the first layer down on Howard before the end of Tuesday.

Starting Thursday, Sept. 21, Illowa Investment, Inc., plans to start milling on Eisenhower Street (from Devitt to Dead End), 5th Avenue (from Webster to Blaine), and 57th Street South (from 67th Avenue to railroad tracks). Parking will not be allowed on these streets starting Wednesday, Sept. 20.

Already milled and awaiting the asphalt overlay are Isett Avenue (East 11th Street to Woodlawn Avenue), Cypress Street (East 11th Street to #9 Alley), and Jefferson Street (Lincoln Avenue to Fillmore Street).

Milling for West Cleveland Street (Isett Avenue to Dead End) and Elfers Street (Grandview Avenue to Dead End) has not been scheduled as yet.
