CITY TRUCKS SPEND DAY SALTING, SANDING AS WINTRY MIX HITS

Hard working crews out late, back on the road after sunrise to keep streets treated

MUSCATINE, Iowa – Department of Public Works trucks have been out since late this morning sanding and salting city streets as a wintry mix moved through the area on Thursday (Jan. 11). The day shift is expected to remain on duty until 10 p.m. when all emergency routes are plowed.

Drivers should expect hazardous travel throughout the nighttime hours with city crews back on the streets at 7 a.m. Friday to salt and plow routes as necessary.

Sunny skies are forecast for Muscatine on Friday with a high temperature around 17 degrees. Wind chill values may be around 10 below zero with winds from the north at 15 mph with gusts to 25 mph.
