SUSPECT ARRESTED FOLLOWING ROBBERY AT KUM & GO

Several charges are filed against Muscatine man; investigation continues

MUSCATINE, Iowa – A 25-year-old Muscatine man was arrested on several charges Wednesday night following a reported robbery at the Kum & Go Convenience Store located at 1429 Park Avenue, Muscatine.

Officers from the Muscatine Police Department responded at 7:51 p.m. Wednesday (March 7) to the alleged robbery at the Kum & Go Convenience Store. Earl Nathanaul Wooten IV, 25, Muscatine, was identified during the initial investigation as the offender.

A Muscatine County deputy and K9 located the suspect in the 500 block of West 5th Street at 8:39 p.m. and the suspect was subsequently arrested.

Wooten is in custody at the Muscatine County Jail for the robbery along with other charges from an earlier theft.
