The meeting was called to order at 5:35 p.m.

Discussion – Phase III Soccer

Meeting was held at the request of the Recreation Advisory Commission to discuss Phase III Soccer Development. Klimes explained how other Parks and Recreation projects have unfolded and the process for shaping each project. Klimes ask the groups what they wanted to see from this meeting. General consensus was to gather more information and begin to narrow the focus of the project. Original concept from 1993 was reviewed, as well as current stipulations on the donation of the land to be developed. Bark presented a concept for an indoor sports facility. Klimes asked the Commission what they would like to see. Livermore would like to see synthetic turf fields. Riley commented that the committee needs to get moving and to get onto the first step, starting with a parking lot. Klimes explained process that must be followed for city projects, and will solicit professional service costs for developing several different types of components.
