## **MUSCATINE ART CENTER SET TO REOPEN DOORS ON JUNE 9**

*Public hours limited with special considerations in place to keep visitors safe*

**MUSCATINE, Iowa** – The Muscatine Art Center will reopen their doors to the public on Tuesday, June 9, according to Melanie Alexander, Director of the Muscatine Art Center. The facility has been closed to the public since March 17, 2020, due to the COVID-19 health crisis.

Visitors to the Muscatine Art Center are asked to enter through the main door off of Mulberry Street so that they can be welcomed at the front desk. Individuals who need wheelchair accessible entry from the Stanley Gallery parking lot may call (563) 263-8282 for assistance and directions.

Visitors are also asked to wear a mask during their visit to the Art Center and observe social distancing guidelines (physical distancing of six feet). Hand sanitizer is provided at the entrance and at various other locations throughout the facility with visitors asked to sanitize their hands when they enter the facility.

Art Center staff will monitor the number of visitors in each area of the facility. Patrons are asked to be prepared to be directed to a specific location or asked to wait before moving into an area that already has many visitors.
