## **FURRY FRIENDS LOVE TO PLAY AT THE MUSCATINE DOG PARK**

*Your canine pal will enjoy the amenities; annual permits available for purchase*

**MUSCATINE, Iowa** – Humans can spoil their pup pals with an annual permit to the Muscatine Dog Park for the rest of the year. Excitable dogs will love running and tussling with new friends while timid or older dogs may just enjoy playing with their human(s) in their very own enclosure.

The Muscatine Dog Park offers many amenities for canines and their humans including three enclosures with benches and seasonal water fountains. The large dog enclosure is three-acres and recommended for dogs measuring 15 inches at the shoulder or taller. Dogs under 15 inches at the shoulder are recommended to play in the small dog area which boasts 1.5 acres. The shy/timid area is perfect for dogs who are new to the park, are being rehabilitated, or prefer solitary play.
