CITY OFFICES CLOSED JANUARY 1 FOR NEW YEAR'S DAY

Holiday schedule released for refuse, recycling collection in Muscatine

MUSCATINE, Iowa – Administrative offices and most departments for the City of Muscatine will be closed on Friday, Jan. 1, 2021, to allow our employees to welcome in the New Year with their families. City administrative offices and departments will reopen at 8 a.m. on Monday, Jan. 4, 2020.



The City of Muscatine public transit system, MuscaBus, will not operate on Friday, Jan. 1, 2021. MuscaBus will resume their normal operations on Saturday, Jan. 2, 2021. Please remember that a mask is required to ride MuscaBus.

The Muscatine Transfer Station will be closed on Friday, Jan. 1, 2021, but will be open 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. (last load on scale at 11:45 a.m.) on Saturday, Jan. 2, 2021. The Transfer Station is also open 7 a.m.-3:30 p.m. Monday-Friday (last load on the scale at 3:15 p.m.). The Transfer Station is closed on Sundays.

The Compost Facility at the Muscatine Transfer Station is closed for the season.

BULKY WASTE COLLECTION – There will be no bulky waste collection Wednesday, Dec. 30, 2020, Thursday, Dec. 31, 2020, Friday, Friday, Jan. 1, 2021, or Monday, Jan. 4, 2021. REFUSE COLLECTION - Curbside refuse and yard waste will not be collected on Friday, Jan. 1, 2021.

- Residents on the Friday route will have their refuse and yard waste collected on Thursday, Dec. 31, along with the regular Thursday route collection.
- All materials for collection should be placed out for pick up after 4 p.m. the day before collection and no later than 5 a.m. on the day of collection.

RECYCLING COLLECTION - There will be no curbside recycling collection on Friday, Friday, Jan. 1, 2021.

- Residents on the Friday “A” Route will have their recycling collected Saturday, Jan. 2, 2021.
- All materials for collection should be placed out for pick up after 4 p.m. the day before collection and no later than 5 a.m. on the day of collection.
