### 5. Review Permits for Historical Properties

The lists of building permits issued in June, July and August were reviewed. Four permits were issued for work on or in historical properties, including 301 E 2<sup>nd</sup> St, 404 W 5<sup>th</sup> ST, 608 W 2<sup>nd</sup> St and 313 W 3<sup>rd</sup>. With the exception of 301 E 2<sup>nd</sup>, which was pouring a driveway, all work was maintenance repair such as roofs and brick and mortar support.
