### **TWO AREAS OF MUSCATINE DOG PARK TO RECEIVE UPGRADES**

*Temporary closures to allow for improvements to entrance pads in two enclosures*



**MUSCATINE, Iowa** – The Small Dog and the Shy & Timid Dog enclosures at the Muscatine Dog Park will be closed Tuesday (April 6) for the installation of additional concrete pads to their respective entrance areas. The Parks and Recreation Department said that the areas should reopen Thursday (April 8), weather permitting.

Annual permits cost \$15.00 and are valid from the date they are purchased until December 31, 2021. Muscatine citizens must also obtain a City Pet License through the Finance Department at Muscatine City Hall.

The Muscatine Dog Park offers many amenities for pooches and their humans including three enclosures, benches and seasonal water fountains. The large dog enclosure is three-acres and is recommended for dogs measuring 15 inches at the shoulder or taller. Dogs under 15 inches at the shoulder are recommended to play in the small dog area which boasts 1.5 acres. The shy/timid area is perfect for dogs who are new to the park, are being rehabilitated or prefer solitary play.
