NO CURBSIDE COLLECTIONS ON MEMORIAL DAY (MAY 31)

Refuse, recycling schedule change; City offices to be closed on Monday

MUSCATINE, Iowa – Curbside collection of refuse, yard waste, bulky waste, and recycling will not be conducted on Monday, May 31, as City of Muscatine staff pauses and reflects on Memorial Day with individuals across the country in remembrance of those who gave the ultimate sacrifice in defense of our nation. City offices will also be closed on Monday.



The City encourages residents to pause, at some point during Memorial Day, and remember those that made the ultimate sacrifice to preserve the freedoms we enjoy.

There will be no curbside refuse or yard waste collection on Monday, May 31. Residents on the Monday route will have their refuse collected on Tuesday, June 1, along with the regular Tuesday route.

There will be no curbside recycling collection on Monday, May 31. Residents on Monday's "A" recycling route will be collected on Tuesday, June 1, with Tuesday's route collected on Wednesday, Wednesday's on Thursday, Thursday's on Friday, and Friday's on Saturday.
