The Department of Public Works is taking applications for an [Equipment Operator I](#) to drive medium to heavy duty trucks hauling various materials, perform manual work in clearing work sites of debris, operate equipment to clean and repair sewer collection systems, and to operate other pieces of light, medium, or heavy equipment in the absence of regular operators or for training purposes.
