Muscatine Police to host event for the first time with fun for the whole family

MUSCATINE, Iowa – National Night Out is an annual community-building campaign that promotes police-community partnerships and neighborhood camaraderie to make neighborhoods across the U.S. safer and more caring places to live.

This year the Muscatine Police Department will be a part of the national celebration and will host its first ever event from 6-9 p.m. Tuesday (Aug. 1) at Taylor Park and Franklin School in Muscatine's south end.
