MAN CHARGED WITH BURGLARY OF WELCH APARTMENTS

MUSCATINE, Iowa – The Muscatine Police Department is investigating a burglary of the Welch Avenue Apartments, 220 Iowa Avenue, Muscatine, that occurred Wednesday afternoon (January 10, 2024).

At approximately 3:18 p.m., Wednesday, officers from the Muscatine Police Department responded to the Welch Avenue Apartments after receiving a report from a contractor doing work in the building that he believed someone was inside. Officers searched the premises and located a suspect in apartment 306.

The suspect, Miguel Angel Salcedo (09/21/71), was taken into custody and charged with 3rd Degree Burglary as well as an unserved arrest warrant.

Upon further investigation, it is believed that multiple apartments were entered and burglarized.
