JUNIOR POLICE ACADEMY - LIFE IN LAW ENFORCEMENT

Students receive hands on experience to learn more about police work

MUSCATINE, Iowa – The Muscatine Police Department, in cooperation with Muscatine Community College, will again offer a FREE summer academy for students ages 14- to 20-years-old. The Junior Police Academy is a five-day training program that will provide students the opportunity to learn about law enforcement.

The Academy will be held from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. from June 9 to June 13, and is designed to develop a greater partnership between the Muscatine Police Department and the community.

- Muscatine Special Operations Team (SWAT)
- Crime Scene Investigation,
- K-9 Operations
- Mock Trial
- Medical Training
- Defensive Tactics

There is no cost to attend and lunch is provided. All high school students are eligible to apply, however space is limited. Preference will be given to juniors and seniors. Those that attend will have an opportunity to earn a \$500 scholarship from the Muscatine Police Officers Association and a \$500 scholarship from Muscatine Community College (if they choose to continue their education at one of the Eastern Iowa Community Colleges).
