INTRODUCTION:

The Police Department sent out bids to vendors throughout Iowa for Four (4) Police Tahoe Police Vehicles. On December 30, 2016 the bids were opened. There were three (3) bids that were turned in.

BACKGROUND:

The Police Department annually replaces at least Five (5) Police Patrol Vehicles every other year. The Police Department has \$202,700 budgeted for the purchase of Police vehicles including the swithover costs.

RECOMMENDATION/RATIONALE:

It is my request that we purchase the Four (4) Police Tahoe Patrol Vehicles from Krieger's. Krieger's bid is within the 2% local match (1.37%). Krieger's bid \$34,760 per Tahoe. The total cost for the Tahoes will be \$139,040, not including the change over costs. Bids received:

1. McGrath Auto of Cedar Rapids bid was \$36081 per Tahoe with a total of \$144,324.
2. Karl Cheverolet of Ankeny bid was \$34,284.44 per Tahoe with a total of \$137,137.76
3. Kriegers of Muscatine bid was \$34,760 per Tahoe with a total of \$139.040.
