INTRODUCTION:

The City of Muscatine has received bids for the rebid of the MDC. These bids have been evaluated for the MDC project. The totals of the two bids are shown below.

KE Flatwork Inc.	\$8,010,348.50
Langman Construction Inc.	\$8,488,948.65

BACKGROUND:

The engineer's estimate for this project is \$9,900,000.00 which does not include a contingency. Five bids were received at the initial bid and two were received at the rebid. The apparent low bidder at the initial bid was KE Flatwork at \$8,670,635.41.

These two bids have been reviewed by the city and Bolton-Menk our consultant and no unbalanced bid prices are apparent. No exclusions are listed and Addendum #1 is included in the bid.

The city would like to proceed as quickly as possible towards contracts and a notice to proceed because of the calendar dates listed in the contract for project deadlines.

RECOMMENDATION/RATIONALE:

The city engineer recommends awarding the MDC Project to KE Flatwork Inc. for \$8,010,348.50.
