Re: REQUEST FOR FAA GRANT APPLICATIONS FOR RESURFACING PARALLEL TAXIWAY TO RUNWAY 6/24

Introduction and Background: The FAA has recently funded the Airport Improvement Program (AIP) with over \$1BB and is soliciting for proposals for infrastructure projects at the Airport. We may have one that qualifies; the parallel taxiway along the newly constructed runway.

There are three types of funding sources we can use from the FAA for AIP projects; scheduled, discretionary and supplemental. Both scheduled and discretionary require the City to provide matching funds of 10% of the grant amount. However, supplemental funding does not require a match but it could use some of the entitlement funds that we have banked for other projects.

This project is for resurfacing the parallel taxiway to runway 6/24 and is estimated to be around \$3MM in total. If successful, construction is scheduled to start in the spring of 2019. It will be applied for in three phases, in the order of most need 1st.

Recommendation: Staff hereby requests of the Council to allow the Community Development Department to apply for (up to three) applications to the FAA.
