Residents will have the opportunity to participate in Spring Cleanup Week on their regularly scheduled trash collection day during the week of April 22-26

Items Accepted for residential curbside pickup

- Large items (furniture, dismantled swing sets, building material) not to exceed a pickup load measuring 8'x4'x2'.
- Up to two (2) appliances. Please remove doors on refrigerators and freezers. No camper refrigerators or camper a/c units.
- Smaller items (i.e., household decorations) are requested to be bagged.

Items Not Accepted for residential curbside pickup

- Torn down buildings (i.e., garages)
- Car bodies
- Large trees or stumps
- Concrete (can be dropped off at Public Works for no cost for no cost).
- Paint and other hazardous chemicals
- Motor Oil and Antifreeze
- Camper refrigerators
- Camper air conditioners

Items Accepted at the Transfer Station at NO CHARGE during Spring Cleanup (Residents Only ... No Businesses)

- May 6-11, 2019 - Up to four (4) car and/or light truck tires without rims.
- May 13-18, 2019 - Up to three (3) electronic waste items including TV's, computers, or items with circuit boards.
- Proof of residency is driver's license, photo ID, or piece of mail with name and address on it.

Items Accepted at the Transfer Station year round at no charge include:

- Batteries
- Paint or other Hazardous chemicals
- Household cleaners
- Medical sharps in a container
- Motor oil and antifreeze
- Propane tanks

Yard waste and brush guidelines for Spring Cleanup Week:

- Yard waste must be in City of Muscatine yard waste bags.
- Brush must be tied in bundles no larger than 18 inches in diameter and 4 feet in length.

Residents of Muscatine and Fruitland may place all bulky, unwanted items out the night before your regular garbage day or by 5:00 a.m. on pick up day. Businesses are not eligible for this service.
