INTRODUCTION:

Roadway Maintenance staff is wanting to Asphalt Overlay Alleys with in the City limits.

BACKGROUND:

The Public Works Department Asphalt Overlays City Alleys and Streets yearly. Every year the Public Works staff submits a list of alleys and or streets that needs to be asphalt over-layered. We make sure these alleys/ streets meet our criterion before being submitted to City Council.

City Staff received five bids on Thursday June 20, 2019. The low bid was from Pro Paving, LLC from Middletown, Iowa in the amount of \$191,559.78. However, the low bidder does not meet the bid specifications for milling and upon follow up with their references we recommend not awarding the contract to Pro Paving, LLC. The next low bid for the project was from Taylor Ridge Paving and Construction from Andalusia, Illinois in the amount of \$208,459.59. This company was the contractor used last year and staff is very pleased with their work and the timely manner with which they completed it.

RECOMMENDATION/RATIONALE:

City Staff recommends awarding the contract to Taylor Ridge Paving and Construction in the amount of \$208,459.59. The estimated amount was \$100,000.00. This is an indefinite quantity, indefinite delivery contract so staff will ensure that the contractor does not go over the budgeted amount available.
