City Council members,

On January 23, 2020 the members of the Muscatine County Joint Communications Commission (MCJCC) met for their regular meeting. At the meeting, the Commission unanimously approved a recommendation to the Muscatine County Board of Supervisors and the Muscatine City Council to amend the 28E agreement that governs the operations of MUSCOM to eliminate the MCJCC and designate the Emergency Management Commission (EMC) as the governing body. Since the current agreement is between the Board of Supervisors and the City of Muscatine, both parties must agree to any amendments. In the past, when changes were proposed, the Board of Supervisors and City Council created an Ad Hoc Committee to draft a potential new 28E Agreement to present back to both parties for approval.

At this time, the MCJCC is seeking approval from the City Council to re-visit the MUSCOM 28E agreement and request that the City appoint the representatives they deem appropriate to serve on the Ad Hoc Committee.

I would be more than happy to attend the City Council meeting in case there are any questions or concerns, if you could advise when it will take place.
