REGISTRATION INFORMATION

PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED - Pre-registration is required except as noted. Registration for all summer programs will begin on Wednesday April 30, 2025, unless otherwise noted.

It's **EASY!** Whether you are at home or the office, it's quick and convenient to register for your favorite programs and activities on our website. TEXT/EMAIL NOTIFICATIONS - When creating your RecDesk account, you can elect to sign up for both email or text message notifications to receive any additional information or changes to your favorite programs or activities.

FEES - All fees are payable at the time of registration. Checks should be made payable to: City of Muscatine. Please do not send cash in the mail. Visa and MasterCard are accepted.

REFUNDS - No refunds will be given after the registration period is closed for an activity unless the Parks and Recreation Department cancels the entire activity. In the event that a program day is not held, a partial fee credit or refund may be considered upon request.

PROGRAM NOTE - Any Programs held on Muscatine School District property is subject to school cancellation rules. Should school be canceled due to any reason, the program will also be canceled. ADDITIONAL SERVICES

DIAMOND RESERVATIONS - Diamond scheduling for games, tournaments, camps and clinics may be requested on a one day less than a year basis. Exceptions will be made for national, regional, and state events. Groups wishing to make reservations for practice sessions may do so as early as the Friday prior to the week of the requested practice. Each team will be allowed a maximum of two (2) 1.5-hour practice times each week. Diamond reservations for a prepared diamond must be made by 11 :00 a.m. of the preceding day, normal business hours, Monday-Friday. Unprepared diamond reservation fees are \$30.00. Prepared diamond reservation fees are \$50.00. These fees will be charged to all nonleague/association requests.

PARK SHELTER USAGE - Shelters are available to the public on a first come, first serve basis. A fee of \$40.00 is charged for shelter reservations. Advance shelter reservations may be made one day less than a year prior to the desired date. Phone reservations are accepted by calling 563-263-0241 with a credit card payment.

FACILITY REFUND - Refunds will be considered if it is requested at least 30 days prior to the reservation. Requests for refunds must be made in writing.

MUSCATINE PARKS AND RECREATION

DEPARTMENT PLAYGROUNDS

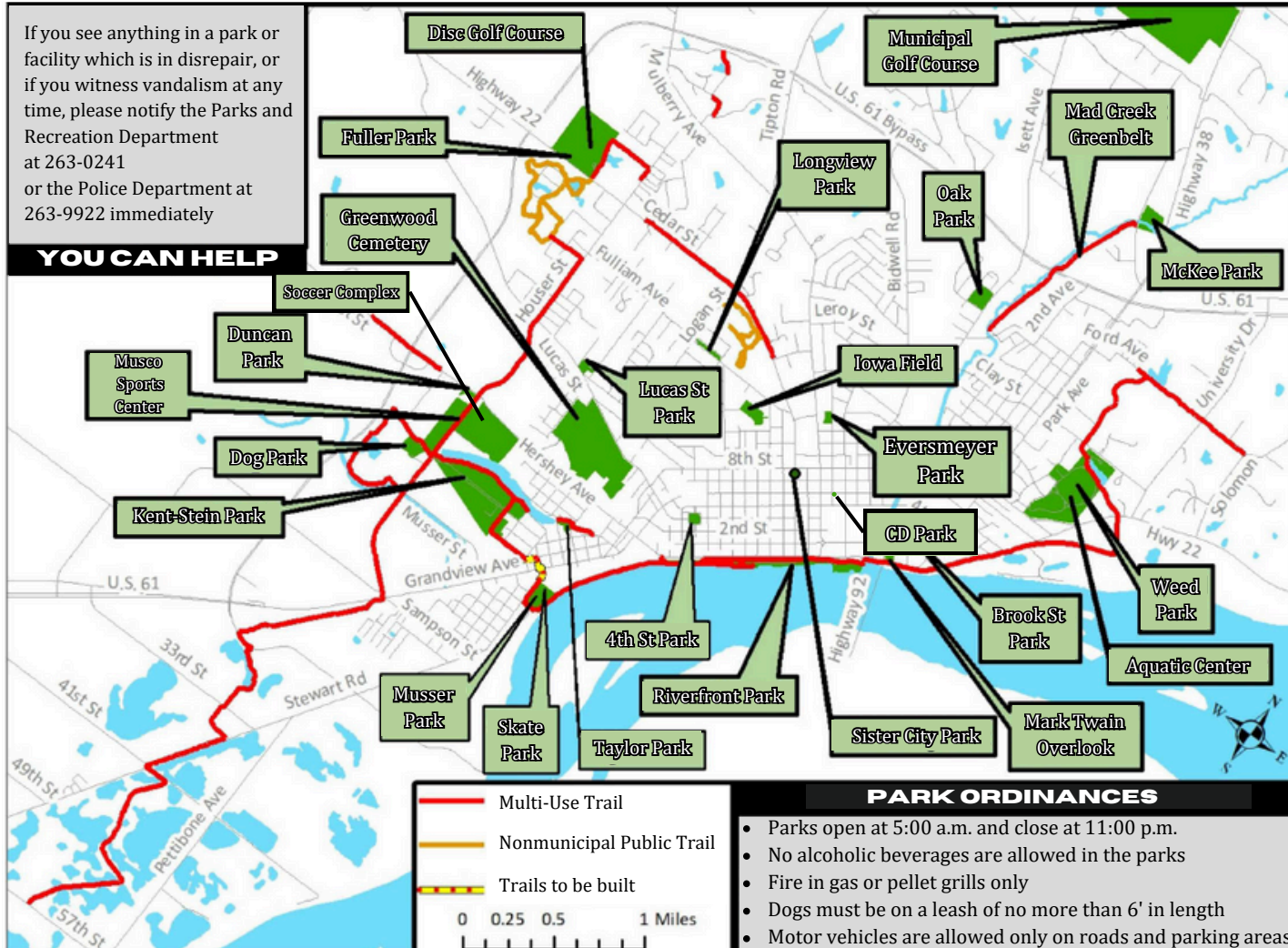
The Muscatine Parks and Recreation Department is home to over 45,000 square feet of colorful, modular, state of the art playgrounds. There are 13 playgrounds in twelve select City neighborhood parks. Each playground is uniquely designed utilizing play equipment appropriate for a wide age range. Poured-in-place rubberized surfacing, which is one of the industry's safest known play surfaces, is under each playground and allows for expanded seasonal playground usage. Playgrounds can be found at the following park sites: Brook Street Park, Eversmeyer Park, Oak Park, Lucas Park, Longview Park, Musser Park, Taylor Park, Fourth Street Park, Riverfront Area, Kruse Memorial Park, and Weed Park.

MUSCATINE DISC GOLF COURSE - The City of Muscatine has an 18-hole disc golf course that is located in Fuller Park on Cedar Street near the bypass. This course accommodates players of all skill levels with wide open shots for the first time recreational player and more difficult holes for those who are seeking more of a challenge. There is no fee to play this course. The course is equipped with ample parking, restrooms, signage, and benches throughout.

MUSCATINE MUNICIPAL BOAT HARBOR - The City of Muscatine operates the Municipal Boat Harbor located by Riverside Park on the mighty Mississippi. The harbor has 8 slips for houseboats and 52 slips for small pleasure and/or speed boats. There are slips available for rent for the current season. Transient Slips are available. Gas, diesel, and pump-out services are also available at the Municipal Marina located in the channel just upriver from the docks. PARK ORDINANCES

- Parks open at 5:00 a.m. and close at 11:00 p.m.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the parks
- Fire in gas or pellet grills only
- Dogs must be on a leash of no more than 6' in length
- Motor vehicles are allowed only on roads and parking areas

RUNNING RIVER BIKE & PEDESTRIAN TRAIL SYSTEM - The City of Muscatine has more than 15 miles of paved and unpaved trails and walkways, as well as more than 20 parks with a combined 550 acres of land. While on trails and walkways in the City, please stay to the right and pass on the left. No motorized vehicles are allowed, unless otherwise posted.

WEED PARK - Weed Park covers in total 64 acres, including a three (3) acre lagoon. The park is home to the Muscatine Aquatic Center, a stocked fishing lagoon, a rose garden and zoo garden, playground equipment, bandstand, restroom facilities, concessions stand, parking areas, picnic areas, seven (7) picnic shelters, eight (8) tennis courts (four lighted) and three (3) sand pit volleyball courts.

GREENWOOD CEMETERY - As a municipally owned and operated facility, Greenwood Cemetery responds to many burial requests including cremations, the financially indigent, military personnel, and children. Greenwood Cemetery contains 80 acres of well-maintained lawns, stately trees, and historical memorials. Greenwood Cemetery also offers a 104-niche columbarium. It is located in a beautiful residential area overlooking the Mississippi River Valley, and is a non-profit, non-sectarian cemetery with a tradition of caring since 1843. The Greenwood Cemetery Chapel was entered into the National Register of Historical Places with the State Historical Society of Iowa in 2002. An annual Cemetery Walk event in the fall allows the public a look into the history of Muscatine and is put on by volunteers and staff of the Muscatine Parks and Recreation Department. We invite you to visit Greenwood Cemetery and personally experience the timeless beauty of this distinctive facility.

MUSCATINE SOCCER COMPLEX - The City of Muscatine invites you to the Muscatine Soccer Complex, which has been recognized by the Sports Turf Managers Association as "Best Soccer Facility". The original complex is a 39 acre, 3.8-million-dollar soccer facility that features eight (8) full-sized state of the art premiere soccer fields. In 2020, a nearly 1.5-million-dollar addition resulted in 17 acres and four (4) lighted fields. Two of the eight original fields are internationally sized, lighted, and contain amended soils. The complex is fully equipped including concessions, restroom facilities, media center, and parking area. The Muscatine Soccer Complex plays host to events sponsored by national, state, and local associations, involving participants of all ages. Camps, clinics, games, and tournaments are welcome. Complex usage may be requested on a one-day less than a year basis. Exceptions will be made for national, regional, and state events.

KENT-STEIN PARK - Kent-Stein Park contains a total of 66 acres and adjoins an 11-acre slough. The park facilities include nine (9) lighted softball diamonds, eight (8) lighted baseball diamonds, and nine (9) lighted horseshoe courts. Other amenities in the park include restroom facilities, two concession stands, picnic areas, and fishing in the slough area. Diamond scheduling for games, tournaments, clinics, and camps may be requested on a one-day less than a year basis. Exceptions will be made for national, regional, or state events.

MISSISSIPPI MIST - The Mississippi Mist is a beautiful water feature located on the Mississippi Riverfront. It is an interactive splash pad with a riverboat smokestack themed center jet that shoots water up to 30 feet in the air. The programmed water display features around the base sprout up at different intervals and includes four mist jets and four outer cannons that shoot water into the center. The water feature is lit and creates as spectacular night show. The splash pad is not attended by a lifeguard and children must be accompanied by adults.

PEARL CITY STATION - Pearl City station is located on the riverfront and is available to the public for meetings, reunions, wedding receptions, and other non-profit events during the months of March through November. This building must be reserved in advance and the fee is dependent on the day/time used and the use of alcohol. The building is equipped with restrooms, tables, and chairs. Pearl City Station is ventilated and has radiating heat (No Air-Conditioning). Reservations can be made with the Parks and Recreation Office.

FEES - Reservation fees are due at the time of reservation. Alcohol Permit fees may be paid anytime between time of reservation and the time keys are to be picked up for the building. Damage Deposit fees are collected by cash or check only and are due when the key for the building is picked up. MUSCATINE SKATE PARK - The Muscatine Skate Park is located at Musser Park. This park offers the Muscatine community an opportunity to use their skateboard, rollerblades, and BMX bikes in an environment where they can improve their skills in a place designed for that purpose. The park includes parking for up to 27 vehicles, a flat track and fenced area with a 100x100 foot stunt area and a 90x50 foot in-line hockey rink. The obstacle/stunt area has a concrete surface with a variety of steel ramps. Lights will shut off automatically at 11:00pm. **NOTICE:** The City of Muscatine does not accept responsibility for injury to persons or damage to property of participants or spectators resulting in games and/or activities held in this area.

RIVERVIEW CENTER - The Riverview Center is located on the riverfront and is available to the public to rent for wedding receptions, family reunions, class reunions, meetings, and other non-profit events year round. Some of the features of the Riverview Center include heating/air-conditioning, accessible elevator and accessible restrooms, a catering kitchen, 15-foot deck on two sides overlooking the river, and approximately 20 tables and 175 chairs. This building must be reserved in advance and the fee will depend on day/time used and the use of alcohol. Reservations can be made with the Parks and Recreation Office.

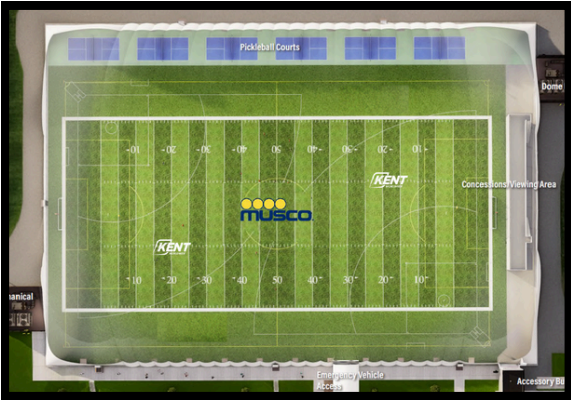

DOG PARK

MUSCATINE DOG PARK - The Muscatine Dog Park is an off-leash community dog park located at 600 South Houser Street across from Kent-Stein Park. The site features include a half-acre shy and timid dog area, a 1.5 acre area for small dogs, and a three-acre enclosure for large dogs. Park amenities include an Entrance Plaza with picnic tables, benches, water fountains with dog bowl, and shelter in each of the three enclosures. The Muscatine Dog Park is open daily from dawn to dusk unless closed for maintenance.

Permit Required - A permit/dog tag must be displayed while using the dog park. To purchase an annual membership, please visit PetData.com/Muscatine or stop by the Muscatine Parks and Recreation Department for a paper copy.

DOG PARK USAGE REGULATIONS

- Dogs must be in view and under control of their handler at all times.
- All handlers must be at least 16 years of age and have a leash in hands at all times. No more than two dogs per handler.
- Children under the age of 16 must be supervised by an adult.
- Handlers are REQUIRED to pick up and dispose of their dog's waste.
- Dogs CANNOT be left alone in the dog park.
- Handlers must stop their dog from digging and must fill in any holes their dog creates.
- Dogs that consistently exhibit dominant aggressive behavior, that regularly do not come when called, that play too rough, and/or that cannot control their barking must be removed from the park immediately and without debate. Multiple violations of this rule may result in permanent bans.
- All dogs must have a valid rabies vaccination tag (Iowa Code 351.35).
- All dogs belonging to City of Muscatine residents must have a valid city license tag (City Code 6-9-2).

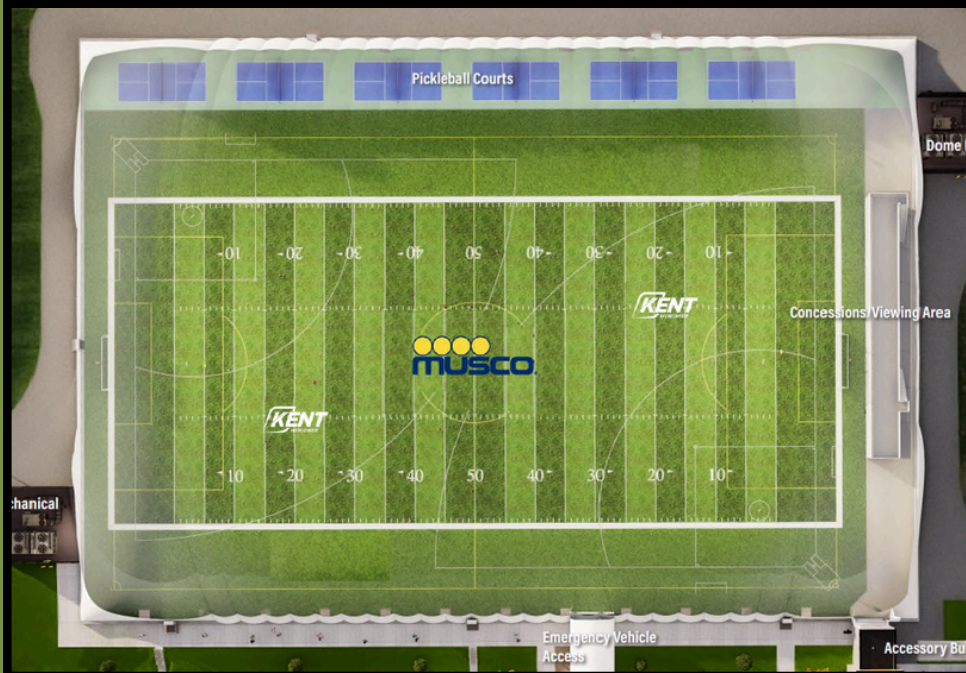
